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(a)(1)(A) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may create paying
 accounts on his or her books and on the books of the Treasurer of the State
 and Auditor of State for the payment of all personal services and operating
 expenses of the Department of Agriculture.

5 (B) Upon prior approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council, or if 6 meeting in Legislative Session the Joint Budget Committee, the Chief Fiscal 7 Officer of the state shall direct the transfer of funds and appropriations to 8 the Shared Services Paying Account appropriation section of this act and the 9 transfer of positions to the Regular Salaries - Shared Services appropriation 10 section of this act on the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of 11 State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

12 (2) The transfer authority provided in subdivision (a)(1) of this 13 section for efficiencies and to eliminate duplication of services are limited 14 only to those services that are provided for multiple divisions of a 15 department, including without limitation to administration, human resources, 16 procurement, communications, fleet operations, and information services.

17 (3) The transfer authority provided to the department in subdivision 18 (a)(1) of this section may be used to make transfers only within the 19 department's appropriation act or between other appropriation acts authorized 20 for the department.

(b)(1) Each department utilizing the Shared Services Paying Account section or Regular Salaries - Shared Services section of this act shall submit a report to be included in the Budget Manuals for hearings, conducted by the General Assembly, listing all shared services transfers of positions, funds, and appropriation under this section, which shall be submitted as instructed by the Department of Finance and Administration - Office of Budget for uniformity.

28 (2) A report submitted under subdivision (b)(1) of this section29 shall include the following:

30 (A) The position number, authorized position title, class
31 code, grade, business area, and name of the division, section, or unit for
32 the position being transferred to the Regular Salaries - Shared Services
33 section of this act; and

(B) The fund center, appropriation, appropriation amount,
commitment item or items, business area, and name of the division, section,
or unit for the fund or appropriation being transferred to the Shared

1 Services Paying Account.

2 (c)(1) It is the intent of the Ninety-Second General Assembly that the 3 authority under this section to transfer positions is intended for use for the 4 time period prior to Fiscal Year 2022 2023 to allow cabinet-level departments 5 to establish a centralized Regular Salaries - Shared Services section, with 6 the recommendation that the position transfer authority granted under this 7 section be discontinued after that time.

8 (2) The Bureau of Legislative Research shall bring the 9 recommendation in subdivision (c)(1) of this section to the attention of the 10 chairs conducting the 2021 <u>2022</u> <u>Regular Fiscal</u> Session pre-session budget 11 hearings, the chairs of the Special Language Subcommittee, and the members of 12 the Special Language Subcommittee during pre-session budget hearings.

13 (d) Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount 14 of appropriation and general revenue funding for a cabinet-level department 15 each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually 16 accomplished by delineating the maximums in the appropriation act or acts and 17 establishing authorized positions and the general revenue allocations 18 authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue 19 Stabilization Law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that the 20 cabinet-level departments created under Acts 2019, No. 910, may operate more 21 efficiently if some flexibility is provided as authorized under this section. 22 Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly 23 maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or, 24 if the General Assembly is in session, the Joint Budget Committee, as 25 provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative 26 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. 27 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 28 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, 29 this entire section is void.

30 (e) The provisions of this section shall be in effect from the date of
31 passage through June 30, 2021 2022.

33 SECTION 36. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 35 TRANSFER. The Deputy Director of the Livestock and Poultry Commission, with 36 prior approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint Budget

1 Committee, the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and for the 2 reimbursing of documented expenditures designated by law to be made from the 3 transferred special revenue, may transfer funds among the Livestock and 4 Poultry Equine Infectious Anemia Control Fund, Livestock and Poultry 5 Commission Disease and Pest Control Fund, Livestock and Poultry Special 6 Revenue Fund, Livestock and Poultry Commission Swine Testing Fund, and the 7 Poultry and Egg Grading Fund or from these funds to the Livestock and Poultry 8 Fund Account. The purpose of these transfers shall only be for accurate 9 allocation of incurred costs between the funds. Requests for fund transfer 10 will at least include the total amount to be transferred, to and from which 11 funds, the nature, purpose, and time period of the expenditures being 12 reimbursed, and any other information requested by the Legislative Council or 13 the Joint Budget Committee.

14 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 15 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 16 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 17 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 18 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 19 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 20 has determined that the Arkansas Agriculture Department - Livestock and 21 Poultry Commission may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is 22 provided to the Arkansas Agriculture Department - Livestock and Poultry 23 Commission authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is 24 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight 25 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 26 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the 27 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this 28 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 29 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent 30 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

SECTION 37. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
 PROVISION - PEST ERADICATION. If the State Plant Board determines that the

demands of pest eradication efforts require additional personnel expenses, with the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, appropriations may be transferred from the Pest Eradication Program special line item to the line items for Regular Salaries, Extra Help, Overtime, and Personal Services Matching.

7 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 8 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 9 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 10 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 11 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 12 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 13 has determined that the State Plant Board may operate more efficiently if 14 some flexibility is provided to the State Plant Board authorizing broad 15 powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate 16 that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of 17 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this 18 section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 19 Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement 20 of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled 21 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is 22 void.

26 SECTION 38. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 28 PROVISION. If the State Forestry Commission determines that temporary 29 firefighters, dispatchers, or pilots are required to meet the demands of a wildfire season, and upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, 30 31 appropriations may be transferred from either Extra Help or Professional Fees 32 and Services to the proper character code for the employment of such 33 personnel.

34 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the deployment of air 35 tankers for fighting wildfires requires additional Professional Fees and 36 Services, and upon the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,

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1 excess appropriation in Regular Salaries or Personal Services Matching may be 2 transferred to Professional Fees and Services in the Operations and Forestry 3 - Rural Community Fire Protection - Federal appropriation sections. 4 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the most effective way for 5 it to cooperate in the growing and distribution of forest planting stock is 6 by contracting work with private vendors and/or hiring temporary employees 7 for seasonal work, the Commission is hereby authorized, upon approval by the 8 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to transfer the necessary appropriation 9 authorized for Extra Help and Maintenance and General Operation in the 10 Operations and Forestry - Rural Community Fire Protection - Federal 11 appropriation sections. 12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020 13 2021 through June 30, 2021 2022. 14 15 SECTION 39. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REFUND TO 17 EXPENDITURE. The Arkansas Forestry Commission is authorized to charge fees 18 to federal agencies and other states to reimburse the Commission for

19 expenditures made on behalf of these governmental units. These fees shall be 20 deposited into the State Forestry Fund in the State Treasury as a refund to 21 expenditure.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020
23 <u>2021</u> through June 30, 2021 <u>2022</u>.

25 SECTION 40. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 27 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall establish 28 upon request for the Arkansas Agriculture Department a special Promotional 29 Items appropriation to be used in the acquisition of promotional items. 30 When the Arkansas Agriculture Department wishes to transfer from its 31 operating expenses to the promotional items line, the request shall be 32 forwarded by the Arkansas Agriculture Department to the Chief Fiscal Officer 33 of the State for processing and for prior approval by the Arkansas 34 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Determining the maximum 35 number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general 36 revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the

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1 General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums 2 in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the 3 4 Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that 5 the Arkansas Agriculture Department may operate more efficiently if some 6 flexibility is provided to the Arkansas Agriculture Department authorizing 7 broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and 8 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior 9 approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by 10 this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or 11 Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the 12 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire 13 section is void. 14

15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020
16 <u>2021</u> through June 30, 2021 <u>2022</u>.

SECTION 41. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 18 19 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 20 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 21 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 23 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 24 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 25 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 26 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

27

28 SECTION 42. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 29 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 30 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 31 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 32 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 33 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 34 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 35 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 36

1	SECTION 43. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
2	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
3	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
4	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of
5	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
6	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
7	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm
8	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
9	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
10	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
11	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.
