Arkansas Code § 24-7-502(a)(2), concerning the termination 3 of active membership under the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System, is amended 4 to read as follows: 5 (2)(A) Effective July 1, 2011, September 1, 2021, a member shall 6 not be terminated from employment for purposes of retirement eligibility if 7 within six (6) calendar months of the member's effective date of retirement 8 the member: 9 (i) Meets both of the following requirements: 10 (A) Becomes employed with an employer 11 covered by the system a covered employer; and 12 (b) (B) Has not attained the system's normal 13 retirement age; or. 14 (ii) Does not have a total or a combined total of 15 thirty-eight (38) years or more of credited service in the system, Teacher Deferred Retirement Option Plan, or reciprocal service in another eligible 16 17 state retirement system. 18 (B) If a member has a combined total of thirty-eight (38) 19 years or more of credited service in the system, Teacher Deferred Retirement 20 Option Plan, or reciprocal credited service in another eligible state retirement system, then the member shall not be terminated from employment 21 22 for purposes of retirement eligibility if within one (1) calendar month of 23 the member's effective date of retirement the member: 24 (i) Becomes employed with an employer covered by the 25 system; and 26 (ii) Has not attained the system's normal retirement 27 age. 28 SECTION 3.
