27	(A) sixty-five Sixty-five (65) years of age if the member
28	has at least five (5) years of actual service; or
29	(B) At least sixty (60) years of age if the member has a
30	combined total of thirty-eight (38) years or more of credited service in the
31	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System, Teacher Deferred Retirement Option Plan,
32	or reciprocal service in another eligible state retirement system;

1 (2)(A) Effective July 1, 2011, September 1, 2021, a member shall 2 not be terminated from employment for purposes of retirement eligibility if within six (6) calendar months of the member's effective date of retirement 3 4 the member: 5 (i) Meets both of the following requirements: 6 (A) Becomes employed with an employer 7 covered by the system a covered employer; and 8 (b) (B) Has not attained the system's normal 9 retirement age; or. 10 (ii) Does not have a total or a combined total of 11 thirty-eight (38) years or more of credited service in the system, Teacher 12 Deferred Retirement Option Plan, or reciprocal service in another eligible 13 state retirement system. 14 (B) If a member has a combined total of thirty-eight (38) 15 years or more of eredited service in the system, Teacher Deferred Retirement 16 Option Plan, or reciprocal credited service in another eligible state 17 retirement system, then the member shall not be terminated from employment 18 for purposes of retirement eligibility if within one (1) calendar month of 19 the member's effective date of retirement the member: 20 (i) Becomes employed with an employer covered by the 21 system; and 22 (ii) Has not attained the system's normal retirement 23 age. 24 25 SECTION 3.
