19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the
22 Department of Commerce - Arkansas Rehabilitation Services, to be payable from
23 the paying account as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
24 for the purpose of paying claims against the State of Arkansas to the payee
25 set out herein:

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30 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the
31 Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division, to be
32 payable from the Individual Income Tax Withholding Fund, for the purpose of
33 paying claims against the State of Arkansas to the payee set out herein:

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Department of Transportation, to be payable from the State Highway and Transportation Department Fund, for the purpose of paying claims against the State of Arkansas to the payee set out herein:

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Public Safety - Division of Arkansas State Police, to be payable from the Division of Arkansas State Police Fund, for the purpose of paying claims against the State of Arkansas to the payee set out herein:

SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Energy and Environment - Division of Environmental Quality, to be payable from the Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund, for the purpose of paying claims against the State of Arkansas to the payee set out herein:

SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRYOVER OF CLAIMS. Any state agency which is affected by the allowed claim(s) provided for in this Act, and whose fund for the ~~2019-2020~~ 2020-2021 fiscal year are insufficient to allow for the payment of said claim(s) before June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021, is hereby authorized, upon certification by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to make payment of said claim(s) after July 1, ~~2020~~ 2021, from funds appropriated for the ~~2020-2021~~ 2021-2022 fiscal year.

SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
2 DISBURSING OFFICER. The Clerk of the State Claims Commission is hereby made
3 the disbursing officer for the purpose of paying the claims appropriated by
4 this Act. The Clerk of the State Claims Commission is hereby authorized to
5 receive all warrants prepared under the provisions of this Act from the
6 Auditor of State and to distribute same to the claimants.

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8 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
10 ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES CLAIMS. For any claims in this Act
11 appropriated to the Department of Human Services, the Clerk of the State
12 Claims Commission shall consult with the Department of Human Services and the
13 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to determine the division and funds to
14 which liability should be assigned and from which the warrants shall be
15 drawn. The Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall initiate the
16 appropriate transfers as may be required and as approved by the Chief Fiscal
17 Officer of the State.

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19 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
21 ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CLAIMS. For any claims in this Act
22 appropriated to the Department of Health, the Clerk of the State Claims
23 Commission shall consult with the Department of Health and the Chief Fiscal
24 Officer of the State to determine the division and funds to which liability
25 should be assigned and from which the warrants shall be drawn. The Clerk of
26 the State Claims Commission shall initiate the appropriate transfers as may
27 be required and as approved by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

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29 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
31 CLAIMS FROM CASH FUNDS. In the event that any claim authorized herein is
32 determined to be a valid claim against the State and the claim is to be paid
33 from funds not in the State Treasury, the Clerk of the State Claims
34 Commission shall notify the agency against which the claim is to be charged
35 of the amount of such claims. Upon receipt of such notification, the state
36 agency shall forth-with deliver a check to the Clerk of the State Claims

1 Commission who shall deposit the same as a nonrevenue receipt into the
2 Miscellaneous Revolving Fund from which he shall disburse the amount of the
3 claim to the claimant.

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5 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
7 EMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION CLAIMS. The Clerk of the State Claims Commission
8 shall not distribute any warrants prepared under the provisions of this Act
9 for awards made by the Arkansas State Claims Commission for employment
10 compensation claims. Upon the award by the State Claims Commission of an
11 employment compensation claim, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall
12 notify the affected state agency and the Department of Finance and
13 Administration - Office of Personnel Management of such amounts that are due
14 and payable. The affected state agency shall then process the award through
15 the State Mechanized Payroll System.

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17 SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
18 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
19 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
20 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
21 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
22 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
23 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
24 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
25 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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27 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
28 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
29 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
30 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
31 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
32 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
33 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
34 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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36 SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the

1 General Assembly, that payees listed in this Act may be entitled to the sums
2 appropriated and transferred to herein, and that they have been deprived of
3 the use of these funds for a long period of time, and that further delay in
4 paying these just debts of the state would do harm to the reputation of the
5 State of Arkansas. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and
6 this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
7 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date
8 of its passage and approval.

9 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
10 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
11 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
12 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
13 the veto.

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
