Arkansas Code § 25-19-103(7), concerning the definitions to 10 be used in the Freedom of Information Act of 1967, is amended to read as 11 follows: 12 (7)(A) "Public records" means writings, recorded sounds, films, 13 tapes, electronic or computer-based information, or data compilations in any 14 medium required by law to be kept or otherwise kept and that constitute a 15 record of the performance or lack of performance of official and related 16 functions that are or should be carried out by a public official or employee, 17 a governmental agency, a private entity as described in subdivision (7)(C) of 18 this section, or any other agency or improvement district that is wholly or 19 partially supported by public funds or expending public funds. All records 20 maintained in public offices or by public employees within the scope of their 21 employment shall be are presumed to be public records. 22 (B) "Public records" does not mean software acquired by 23 purchase, lease, or license;. (C)(i) "Public records" includes writings, recorded 24 25 sounds, films, tapes, electronic or computer-based information, or data compilations in any medium maintained by a: 26 27 (a) Private entity that is: 28 (1) Supported wholly or in part by 29 public funds or the expending of public funds; and 30 (2) Engaged in activities or the provision of services that would normally be provided by a governmental 31 32 entity or would be provided by a governmental entity in the absence of the 33 private entity; or 34 (b) Private entity with the primary purpose of 35 providing direct support to a governmental agency or public entity 36 financially or with labor if the direct support provided had an actual or

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1	equivalent value of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) or more in the previous

4	(a) Writings, recorded sounds, films, tapes,		
5	electronic or computer-based information, or data compilations in any medium		
6	of a private entity that are not related to the performance of a public or

8	governmental agency by the private entity; or		
9	(b) The names and personal contact information		
10	of persons making financial donations to a private entity as described in		
11	subdivision (7)(C)(i)(b) of this section;
