33	SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPO	RATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
34	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND T	EMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL
35	ALLOWANCE. The Board of Trustees of the University of	Central Arkansas may
36	make special allowances available to any coach who co	eaches more than one

1 sport in an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per fiscal 2 year for any one coach. Further, the Board of Trustees of the University of 3 Central Arkansas is hereby authorized to make additional payments to head 4 coaches at the University of Central Arkansas from revenues generated by 5 contracts with vendors of athletic apparel, shoes and other products in such 6 amounts as may be established by the Board of Trustees for performance by the 7 coaches of consulting and other obligations pursuant to contracts between the 8 University and such vendors. Such additional payments to head coaches shall 9 not be considered salary and shall not be deemed or construed to exceed the 10 maximum salaries established for such coaches by the Act. 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SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TUITION REIMBURSEMENT. The Board of Trustees of the University of Central Arkansas shall be authorized to reimburse tuition, fees, and other educational related expenses of current faculty who seek additional education levels that will benefit the university in meeting accreditation and professional standards. Reimbursement shall be authorized only when the reimbursement request has been documented by the institution to meet critical shortage instructional areas.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020

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SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

1 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 2 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 3 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 4 5 with in disbursement of said funds. 6 7 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 9 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 10 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 15 16 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 17 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 18 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 19 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of 20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 21 22 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm 23 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 24 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 25 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021. 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35

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
