Arkansas Code § 12-29-306 - 12-29-310, concerning the 11 Riverside Vocational and Technical School, are repealed. 12 12-29-306. Riverside Vocational and Technical School - Legislative 13 intent. 14 (a) This section and §§ 12-29-307 - 12-29-310 are intended to create 15 an additional state vocational and technical school to provide vocational and 16 technical education and training opportunities to qualified persons 17 incarcerated in facilities of the Division of Correction and the Division of 18 Community Correction or to qualified persons supervised by the Division of 19 Community Correction, including those on probation and parole or any type of 20 post-prison release or transfer. 21 (b) This section and §§ 12-29-307 - 12-29-310 are not intended to 22 modify or repeal any of the laws of this state pertaining to vocational and 23 technical schools or vocational and technical education. 24 25 12-29-307. Riverside Vocational and Technical School - Establishment. 26 There is established a state vocational and technical school, to be 27 known as the "Riverside Vocational and Technical School", to be operated by 28 the Division of Correction and the Division of Community Correction at such facilities of the Division of Correction and the Division of Community 29 30 Correction as may be designated by the Board of Corrections. 31 32 12-29-308. Riverside Vocational and Technical School - Purpose. 33 The Riverside Vocational and Technical School is created for the 34 purpose of providing vocational and technical educational opportunities to qualified persons incarcerated in facilities of the Department of Correction 35 36 and the Department of Community Correction or to qualified persons supervised

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1 by the Department of Community Correction, including those on probation and 2 parole or any type of post prison release or transfer who would be qualified to receive vocational and technical education and training in state 3 4 vocational and technical schools established by the Career Education and 5 Workforce Development Board under the provisions of §§ 6-51-201 - 6-51-203, 6 6-51-205, 6-51-207 - 6-51-210, and other laws of this state relative to 7 vocational and technical schools. 8 12-29-309. Riverside Vocational and Technical School - Facilities -9 10 Operations - Rules. 11 (a)(1) The Division of Correction and the Division of Community 12 Correction shall locate facilities and operate vocational or technical 13 education or training programs within the Riverside Vocational and Technical 14 School. 15 (2) The operation of the school is subject to such special rules 16 deemed appropriate for the operation of vocational or technical education or 17 training programs at the correctional institutions under the control of the 18 Division of Correction and the Division of Community Correction in accordance 19 with agreements and rules mutually developed and agreed to by the Department of Education and the Board of Corrections. 20 21 (b)(1) The school shall be entitled to all funds, rights, and 22 privileges and shall be operated in the same manner as other area vocational 23 and technical schools are operated in this state. 24 (2) However, the school shall be operated in accordance with the rules for the operation of vocational or technical education or training 25 26 programs at facilities of the Division of Correction and the Division of 27 Community Correction as provided in §§ 12-29-306 - 12-29-310. 28 12-29-310. Riverside Vocational and Technical School - Cost of 29 30 implementation and operation. 31 (a) The cost of implementing and operating the Riverside Vocational 32 and Technical School at facilities of the Division of Correction and the 33 Division of Community Correction as authorized by this section and §§ 12-29-306 - 12-29-309 shall be borne by the state and shall be paid from funds 34 appropriated by the General Assembly to the school, the Division of 35

36 Correction, and the Division of Community Correction, together with any

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federal funds that may be available for this purpose in the following manner: (1) The cost of facilities and equipment in excess of the amount of moneys provided by the school shall be borne by the Division of Correction and the Division of Community Correction as approved by the Board of Corrections; and (2)(A) This section and §§ 12-29-306 12-29-309 contemplate that the Division of Correction and the Division of Community Correction will provide facilities for the vocational and technical education programs operated by the school. (B) However, nothing in this section and §§ 12-29-306 -12-29-309 shall prohibit the Career Education and Workforce Development Board from providing facilities or sharing in the cost of facilities and from providing or sharing in the cost of repairing, maintenance, and upkeep of the buildings and facilities with the Division of Correction and the Division of Community Correction as funds are provided by the General Assembly, or are otherwise available for these purposes. (b) The school shall be administered under the direction and supervision of the chief administrative officer of the Corrections School System or the Director of the Riverside Vocational and Technical School under the direct authority of the Board of Directors of the Corrections School System.
