8	additional subdivision to read as follows:				
9	(4) "Follow-up colonoscopy" means a colonoscopy that is				
10	performed as a follow-up to a colorectal cancer screening test, other than a				
11	colonoscopy, the result of which is:				
12	(A) Positive; and				
13	(B) Assigned either a grade of "A" or a grade of "B" by				
14	the United States Preventive Services Task Force.

16	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 23-79-1202(b), concerning coverage for				
17	colorectal cancer examinations and laboratory tests, is amended to read as				
18	follows:				
19	(b) The coverage shall include colorectal cancer examinations and				
20	laboratory tests for:				
21	(1) Covered persons who are fifty (50) forty-five (45) years of				
22	age or older;				
23	(2) Covered persons who are less than fifty (50) years forty-				
24	five (45) of age and at high risk for colorectal cancer according to American				
25	Cancer Society colorectal cancer screening guidelines as they existed on				
26	January 1, 2005 January 1, 2021; and				
27	(3) Covered persons experiencing or meeting the following				
28	criteria or symptoms of colorectal cancer as determined by a physician				
29	licensed under the Arkansas Medical Practices Act, § 17-95-201 et seq., § 17-				
30	95-301 et seq., and § 17-95-401 et seq.:				
31	(A) Bleeding from the rectum or blood in the stool; or				
32	(B) A change in bowel habits, such as diarrhea,				
33	constipation, or narrowing of the stool, that lasts more than five (5) days:

35	(C) The need for a follow-up colonoscopy.

- 2 23-79-1204. Exclusions and reductions Benefits subject to annual
- 3 deductible and coinsurance.
- 4 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section and § 23-79-
- 5 1207, the coverage offered under § 23-79-1202 may contain any exclusions,
- 6 reductions, or other limitations approved by the Insurance Commissioner
- 7 concerning coverages, deductibles, or coinsurance provisions.
- 8 (b) The benefits provided in this subchapter shall be are subject to
- 9 the same annual deductible or coinsurance established for all other covered
- 10 benefits within a healthcare policy.

- 13 23-79-1207. Cost-sharing.
- 14 (a) To encourage colorectal cancer screenings, patients and healthcare
- 15 providers may not shall not be required to meet burdensome criteria or
- 16 overcome significant obstacles to obtain coverage.
- 17 (b)(1) An Except as provided in subdivision (b)(2) of this section, an
- 18 individual shall not be required to pay an additional deductible or
- 19 coinsurance for testing that is greater than an annual deductible or
- 20 coinsurance established for similar benefits.
- 21 (2) (A) Beginning on and after January 1, 2022, a healthcare
- 22 policy offered to an employee at the time of hiring or healthcare policy
- 23 renewal shall not contain a cost-sharing requirement for a follow-up
- 24 <u>colonoscopy</u>.
- 25 (B) A covered person shall not be subject to a deductible,
- 26 coinsurance, or any other cost-sharing requirement for services received from
- 27 participating providers under a healthcare policy, as an initial screening
- 28 test is not considered complete until a follow-up colonoscopy is performed.
- 29 (c) If the program or contract does not cover a similar benefit, a
- 30 deductible or coinsurance may not shall not be set at a level that materially
- 31 diminishes the value of the colorectal cancer benefit required under this

- 33 (d) Reimbursement to healthcare providers for colorectal cancer
- 34 screenings provided under this section shall be equal to or greater than
- 35 reimbursement to healthcare providers under Medicare, Title XVII of the
- 36 Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. § 1395 et seq., as it existed on January 1,
