SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR
MATHEMATICS, SCIENCES AND THE ARTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
University of Arkansas, to be payable from the School for Math, Sciences, and
Arts Fund, for operating expenses of the University of Arkansas - Arkansas
School for Mathematics, Sciences and the Arts which shall be supplemental and
in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 8 of Act 140 of 2020, the
following:

SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

2	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
3	Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of		
4	the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville are, due to unforeseen		
5	circumstances, insufficient for the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville to		
6	continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of		
7	this act will provide the necessary monies for the University of Arkansas at		
8	Fayetteville to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective		
9	date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration		
10	and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is		
11	hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate		
12	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force		
13	and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.		
14	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall		
15	become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the		
16	Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the		
17	veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house		
18	overrides the veto.
