AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR OPERATING
EXPENSES FOR THE SAU-TECH WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL
AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT
130 OF 2020; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE SAU-TECH SUPPLEMENTAL
APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
appropriated, to the SAU-Tech, to be payable from the SAU-Tech Fund, for
operating expenses of the SAU-Tech which shall be supplemental and in
addition to those funds appropriated in Section 3 of Act 130 of 2020, the
following:

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS - FIRE TRAINING ACADEMY.

There is hereby appropriated, to the SAU-Tech, to be payable from the SAU-Tech Fund, for operating expenses of the SAU-Tech - Fire Training Academy which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 6 of Act 130 of 2020, the following:

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS - ENVIRONMENTAL TRAINING ACADEMY. There is hereby appropriated, to the SAU-Tech, to be payable from the SAU-Tech Fund, for operating expenses of the SAU-Tech - Environmental Training Academy which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 9 of Act 130 of 2020, the following:

SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
3 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
4 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

7 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
9 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
10 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

16 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
17 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
18 the SAU-Tech are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the SAU-
19 Tech to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the
20 provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the SAU-Tech to
21 continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act
22 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of
23 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared
24 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
25 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
26 after the date of its passage and approval.

27 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall
28 become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the
29 Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the
30 veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house
31 overrides the veto.
