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22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:		
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24	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,		
25	to the Black River Technical College, to be payable from cash funds as		
26	defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801, for construction, construction fees, and		
27	equipping a Law Enforcement Training Academy Barracks of the Black River		
28	Technical College, which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds		
29	appropriated in Act 27	of 2020, the following:

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1 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 2 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 3 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 4 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 7 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 8 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 9 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 10 11 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 12 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 13 14 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 15 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 16 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 17 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 18 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 19 20 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 21 22 the Black River Technical College are, due to unforeseen circumstances, 23 insufficient for the Black River Technical College to continue to provide 24 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide 25 the necessary monies for the Black River Technical College to continue such 26 services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work 27 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist 28 29 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 30 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. 31 32 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall 33 become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the 34 Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house 35 36 overrides the veto.
