- 16 from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. The request shall clearly state
- 17 the amount required and such other information as may be required by the
- 18 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State necessary to make a decision regarding the
- 19 request. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior
- 20 review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the
- 21 State Auditor shall be notified as of the amount and the purposes for which
- 22 the appropriation and/or funding is to be transferred and shall be
- 23 established upon the books of the Department of Finance and Administration
- 24 and the State Auditor. If desired, the appropriation may be supplemental to
- 25 those regularly appropriated for like purposes by the General Assembly for
- 26 that agency.
- 27 Provided further, that all state agencies, boards or commissions shall
- 28 have prior approval by the Building Authority Division as authorized for the
- 29 Sustainable Building Design Program in accordance with established Rules and
- 30 Regulations.
- 31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020
- 32 2021 through June 30, 2021 2022.

- 34 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 36 SUSTAINABLE BUILDING DESIGN PROGRAM REVOLVING LOAN FUND. The Sustainable

- 1 Building Design Program Appropriation is intended to provide additional
- 2 appropriation authority for the Sustainable Building Design Program. Funding
- 3 for the program may be made available by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
- 4 State, in the form of a loan, from a transfer from the Sustainable Building
- 5 Design Revolving Loan Fund after the required review by the Arkansas
- 6 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, approval by the Chief Fiscal
- 7 Officer of the State and approval through rules and regulations established
- 8 and administered by Building Authority Division. Moneys made available for
- 9 the repayment of a loan shall be deposited to the credit of the Sustainable
- 10 Building Design Revolving Loan Fund as a "Refund to Expenditure" for the year
- 11 in which the deposit is made. In the event that the funds for the repayment
- 12 of a loan are held in depositories other than the State Treasury, the
- 13 administrative head of the affected state agency shall issue a check drawn
- 14 against the funds, which shall be deposited in the Sustainable Building
- 15 Design Revolving Loan Fund.
- 16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2020}{1}$
- 17 2021 through June 30, 2021 2022.

- 19 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
- 21 TRANSFER GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS DEVELOPMENT AND ENHANCEMENT FUNDS. The
- 22 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may transfer from time to time on his or
- 23 her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State
- 24 funding which is made available from General Improvement Funds Development
- 25 <u>and Enhancement Funds</u> allocated and distributed to Building Authority
- 26 Division in an amount not to exceed three million dollars (\$3,000,000) from
- 27 the General Improvement Fund Development and Enhancement Fund or its
- 28 successor fund or fund accounts to the Sustainable Building Design Revolving
- 29 Loan Fund to provide funds for the appropriation provided herein or for
- 30 appropriation authority as may be provided by law to provide loans to
- 31 agencies for the Sustainable Building Design Program.
- 32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020
- 33 2021 through June 30, 2021 2022.

- 35 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING

- 1 TRANSFER FEDERAL FUNDS. From time to time, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
- 2 State may transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and
- 3 the Auditor of the State the sum not to exceed twelve million dollars
- 4 (\$12,000,000) from Federal Funds as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of
- 5 the State to the Sustainable Building Design Revolving Loan Fund to provide
- 6 funds for the appropriations herein.
- 7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2020}{1}$
- 8 2021 through June 30, 2021 2022.

- 10 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
- 12 TRANSFER CASH FUND ACCOUNT. Building Authority Division is authorized to
- 13 transfer any unspent funds remaining in any cash fund account established for
- 14 the management of a state owned facility managed by, but not owned by,
- 15 Building Authority Division to the Building Authority Maintenance Fund to
- 16 support the facility's Maintenance and Operations appropriations.
- 17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020
- 18 2021 through June 30, 2021 2022.

- 20 SECTION 23. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 21 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 22 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 23 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 24 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 25 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 26 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 27 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 28 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

- 30 SECTION 24. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
- 31 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
- 32 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
- 33 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
- 34 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
- 35 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
- 36 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

1	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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3	SECTION 25. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
4	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
5	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
6	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of
7	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
8	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
9	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm
10	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
11	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
12	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
13	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.
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
