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25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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27	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 15, Chapter 32, Subchapter 1, is	
28	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:	
29	15-32-102. Gated residential community logging permit.	
30	(a) Before logging in a gated residential community as described	in
31	subsection (b) of this section, an individual shall:	
32	(1) Apply for and obtain a gated residential community log	ging
33	permit from the Department of Agriculture; and	
34	(2) Certify in the application that he or she will follow	the
35	Arkansas Forestry Commission's Best Management Practices for Water Qual	<u>ity</u>
36	Protection.	



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1	(b) An individual shall obtain the gated residential community logging		
2	permit under subsection (a) of this section before logging in a gated		
3	residential community if, within a period of six (6) months, the individual		
4	is cutting ten (10) or more trees that are:		
5	(1) Over six inches (6") in diameter per acre;		
6	(2) Located on three (3) or more acres; and		
7	(3) Located inside of the gated residential community and within		
8	two thousand feet (2000') of a residential dwelling within the gated		
9	residential community.		
10	(c)(l) The department shall conduct an inspection after the individual		
11	has logged on one (1) acre to ensure the individual is following the		
12	commission's Best Management Practices for Water Quality Protection.		
13	(2)(A) If the individual has not complied with the commission's		
14	Best Management Practices for Water Quality Protection, the department shall		
15	allow the individual fourteen (14) days to comply with the commission's Best		
16	Management Practices for Water Quality Protection.		
17	(B)(i) Following the fourteen (14) days provided under		
18	subdivision (c)(2)(A) of this section, the department shall reinspect for		
19	compliance with the commission's Best Management Practices for Water Quality		
20	Protection.		
21	(ii) If upon reinspection the department finds that		
22	the individual has not complied with the commission's Best Management		
23	Practices for Water Quality Protection, the department shall revoke the		
24	individual's gated residential community logging permit.		
25	(d) If an individual's gated residential community logging permit is		
26	revoked under subdivision (c)(2)(B)(ii) of this section, he or she shall not		
27	be issued another gated residential community logging permit under this		
28	section until he or she has shown compliance with the commission's Best		
29	Management Practices for Water Quality Protection as verified by the		
30	department.		
31	(e) The department shall issue to an individual only one (1) gated		
32	residential community logging permit at a time under this section.		
33	(f) The fee for a gated residential community logging permit under		
34	this section is one hundred dollars (\$100).		
35	(g) This section does not apply to a public utility as defined in §		
36	<u>23-1-101 operating as an electric utility or a municipal electric utility</u>
