8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES
9 FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS FOR MEDICAL SCIENCES
10 WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE
11 FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 139 OF 2020; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES.

15 AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS FOR
16 MEDICAL SCIENCES SUPPLEMENTAL
17 APPROPRIATION.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - WINTHROP P. ROCKEFELLER CANCER INSTITUTE.

23 There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas for Medical
24 Sciences, to be payable from the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences
25 National Cancer Institute Designation Trust Fund, for personal services of
26 the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences - Winthrop P. Rockefeller
27 Cancer Institute, which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
28 appropriated in Act 139 of 2020, the following:

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35 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
36 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency



1 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
2 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
3 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
4 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
5 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
6 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
7 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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9 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
10 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
11 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
12 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
13 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
14 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
15 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
16 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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18 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
19 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
20 the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences are, due to unforeseen
21 circumstances, insufficient for the University of Arkansas for Medical
22 Sciences to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the
23 provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the University
24 of Arkansas for Medical Sciences to continue such services; and that a delay
25 in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper
26 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
27 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
28 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
29 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

30 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall
31 become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the
32 Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the
33 veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house
34 overrides the veto.
