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Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism shall annually develop a schedule 1 2 of base fees, rates, tolls, charges, and rentals for lodging, camping, 3 events, services, and all other accommodations offered across the state parks 4 system. 5 (3) The division shall submit annually the schedule of fees, 6 rates, tolls, charges, and rentals to the commission for review and approval. 7 (4) The division may increase or decrease approved fees, rates, 8 tolls, charges, and rentals charged for lodging, camping, events, services, 9 and all other accommodations by up to fifty percent (50%) using a dynamic 10 pricing strategy based on market forces such as seasonal variation in demand, 11 occupancy, market analysis, and special event interest in order to maximize 12 revenues from the use of state resources to promote the fiscal soundness and 13 long-term sustainability of the state parks system. (5) The division shall submit annually a report regarding the 14 15 implementation of the dynamic pricing strategy to the commission and the 16 Legislative Council. 17 (6) The fees, rates, tolls, charges, and rentals established 18 under this subchapter are not subject to the rulemaking requirements of the 19 Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq. 20 The authority and power of the commission includes the right to (b) 21 erect and operate cabins, lodges, restaurants, and other facilities and 22 improvements for the convenience of the public and the right to erect and 23 lease to third parties for operation such facilities and improvements upon 24 such terms as the commission may determine. 25 The commission shall revise the rates, fees, tolls, charges, (c)(1) 26 and rentals whenever necessary to ensure that the revenues therefrom from 27 rates, fees, tolls, charges, and rentals, together with other available 28 funds, shall be fully sufficient to discharge all obligations of the 29 commission pertaining to the principal of and interest on any bonds as the 30 principal and interest become due. 31 (2) The gross revenue derived by the commission from all or any 32 part of the properties and equipment of the state parks system may be pledged 33 to the payment of revenue bonds authorized to be issued by this subchapter 34 even though the proceeds from a particular bond issue may be used for the 35 development or improvement of one (1) or more, but less than all, state 36 parks.
