- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 14-238-106(c), concerning the petitioning of the quorum court by a public facility board for a grant of powers, is amended to read as follows to eliminate an ambiguity in the wording of the section:
- (c) Any public facility board created under the Public Facilities Boards Act, § 14-137-101 et seq., or its predecessor, for the purpose of operating a waterworks facility and/or or a wastewater facility, or both, and which is in existence on July 28, 1995, may petition the quorum court which created the board to grant the board all the powers conveyed by this chapter, and if the quorum court adopts an ordinance to that effect, the powers and authority granted under this chapter shall be applicable to that public facilities board, and it shall thereafter be governed exclusively by the provisions of this chapter and none other.

- SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 14-238-111(a)(6), concerning the powers of a board under the Rural Waterworks Facilities Boards Act, is amended to read as follows to eliminate an ambiguity in the wording of the section:
- (6) To lend money, directly or indirectly, for the financing of the construction, acquisition, and equipment of all or a portion of a waterworks facility project and/or or a wastewater facility project, or both;

- SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 14-238-112(a), concerning the power of a county to acquire facilities under the Rural Waterworks Facilities Boards Act, is amended to read as follows to eliminate an ambiguity in the wording of the section:
- (a) Any county may acquire facilities for a waterworks facility project and/or or a wastewater facility project, or both, or any portion thereof, including a project site, by gift, purchase, lease, or condemnation, and may transfer any such facilities to a board created by the county by sale, lease, or gift.

SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 14-238-113(a), concerning the purposes for which a board may use funds and issue bonds under the Rural Waterworks

- 1 Facilities Boards Act, is amended to read as follows to eliminate an 2 ambiguity in the wording of the section:
 - (a) Boards are authorized to use any available funds and revenues for the accomplishment of all or a portion of waterworks facilities <u>projects</u> and/or or wastewater facilities projects, or both, and may issue bonds, as authorized by this subchapter, for the accomplishment of all or a portion of waterworks facilities <u>projects</u> and/or or wastewater facilities projects, or both, either alone or together with other available funds and revenues.

- SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 14-238-114(a)(3), concerning the authority of a board to make successive bond issues under the Rural Waterworks Facilities Boards Act, is amended to read as follows to eliminate an ambiguity in the wording of the section:
 - (3)(A) There may be successive bond issues for the purpose of financing the same waterworks facilities <u>project</u> and/or or wastewater facilities project, or both, and there may be successive bond issues for financing the cost of reconstructing, replacing, constructing additions to, extending, improving, and equipping waterworks facilities <u>projects</u> and/or or wastewater facilities projects, or both, already in existence, whether or not originally financed by bonds issued under this subchapter, with each successive issue to be authorized as provided by this subchapter.
 - (B) Priority between and among issues and successive issues as to security of the pledge of revenues and lien on the waterworks facilities <u>project</u> and/or or the wastewater facilities project, or both, involved may be controlled by the resolution authorizing the issuance of the bonds.

- SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 14-238-116(a), concerning the source of revenue from which the principal and interest on bonds issued under the Rural Waterworks Facilities Boards Act may be paid, is amended to read as follows to eliminate an ambiguity in the wording of the section:
 - (a) The principal of and interest on the bonds shall be payable from:
- (1) Revenues derived from the waterworks facilities <u>projects</u> and/or or the wastewater facilities projects, or both, acquired, constructed, reconstructed, equipped, extended, or improved, in whole or in part, with the proceeds of the bonds;

1	(2) Obligations of:		
2	(A) The owners of waterworks facilities projects and/or or		
3	wastewater facilities projects, or both; or		
4	(B) Any person with whom the proceeds of the bonds, or a		
5	portion thereof, are invested by contract or otherwise;		
6	(3) Any other funds or sources of funds of the board		
7	specifically pledged and which are set aside as a special fund or source,		
8	other than taxes or assessments for local improvements, for the purpose of		
9	paying the principal of and interest on the bonds; or		
10	(4) Any combination of subdivisions (a)(1)-(3) of this section.		
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12	SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 14-238-118(a)(1), concerning the		
13	appointment of a receiver in case of default on the payment of principal and		
14	interest on bonds issued under the Rural Waterworks Facilities Boards Act, i		
15	amended to read as follows to eliminate an ambiguity in the wording of the		
16	section:		
17	(a)(1) In the event of a default in the payment of the principal of or		
18	interest on any bonds issued under the provisions of this chapter, any court		
19	having jurisdiction may appoint a receiver to take charge of the waterworks		
20	facilities projects and/or or the wastewater facilities projects, or both,		
21	upon or in which there is a mortgage lien or security interest securing the		
22	bonds in default.		
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24	SECTION 10. Arkansas Code § 14-286-105(e), concerning ex officio		
25	members of a board of commissioners for a red imported fire ant abatement		
26	district, is amended to read as follows to eliminate an ambiguity in the		
27	wording of the section:		
28	(e)(1) A Cooperative Extension Services University of Arkansas		
29	Cooperative Extension Service specialist involved in fire ant education		
30	and/or or the county agent chairman chair, or both, shall serve as ex officion		
31	members of the board and shall serve without compensation.		
32	(2) The Cooperative Extension Services <u>University of Arkansas</u>		
33	Cooperative Extension Service specialist, and the county agent, or their		
34	representatives, shall cooperate with and assist the board by furnishing the		
35	board with such surveys, maps, information, and advice as may be helpful to		
36	the board in carrying out its responsibilities and to assist in such other

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3	SECTION 11. DO NOT CODIFY. CONSTRUCTION AND LEGISLATIVE INTENT.	
4	It is the intent of the General Assembly that:	
5	(1) The enactment and adoption of this act shall not expressly	
6	or impliedly repeal an act passed during the regular session of the Ninety-	
7	Third General Assembly;	
8	(2) To the extent that a conflict exists between an act of the	
9	regular session of the Ninety-Third General Assembly and this act:	
10	(A) The act of the regular session of the Ninety-Third	
11	General Assembly shall be treated as a subsequent act passed by the General	
12	Assembly for the purposes of:	
13	(i) Giving the act of the regular session of the	
14	Ninety-Third General Assembly its full force and effect; and	
15	(ii) Amending or repealing the appropriate parts of	
16	the Arkansas Code of 1987; and	
17	(B) Section 1-2-107 shall not apply; and	
18	(3) This act shall make only technical, not substantive, changes	
19	to the Arkansas Code of 1987.	
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
