AN ACT TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 22 OF
THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING PUBLIC PROPERTY; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 22
OF THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING PUBLIC
PROPERTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 22-10-502(a), concerning rules promulgation by the Arkansas Economic Development Commission under the Partnership for Public Facilities and Infrastructure Act, is amended to read as follows to correct a reference to an agency and to repeal obsolete language:

(a) ~~The Arkansas Economic Development Commission or the Building Authority Division~~ Department of Transformation and Shared Services shall promulgate certain rules regarding the definitions and guidelines related to the development of qualifying projects under this chapter within ninety (90) days of August 1, 2017.

SECTION 2. The introductory language of Arkansas Code § 22-10-503(a), concerning rules promulgation by the Arkansas Economic Development Commission and the Arkansas Development Finance Authority under the Partnership for Public Facilities and Infrastructure Act, is amended to read as follows to correct a reference to an agency:



(a) ~~The Arkansas Economic Development Commission or the Building Authority Division~~ Department of Transformation and Shared Services and the Arkansas Development Finance Authority shall jointly promulgate rules to administer this chapter, including without limitation rules regarding:

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 22-10-503(b), concerning rules promulgation by the Arkansas Economic Development Commission and the Arkansas Development Finance Authority under the Partnership for Public Facilities and Infrastructure Act, is amended to read as follows to correct a reference to an agency:

(b) ~~The commission or division and the authority~~ Department of Transformation and Shared Services and the Arkansas Development Finance Authority may jointly promulgate rules that establish procurement guidelines and requirements that vary depending on the type of qualifying project.

SECTION 4. DO NOT CODIFY. CONSTRUCTION AND LEGISLATIVE INTENT.

It is the intent of the General Assembly that:

(1) The enactment and adoption of this act shall not expressly or impliedly repeal an act passed during the regular session of the Ninety-Third General Assembly;

(2) To the extent that a conflict exists between an act of the regular session of the Ninety-Third General Assembly and this act:

(A) The act of the regular session of the Ninety-Third General Assembly shall be treated as a subsequent act passed by the General Assembly for the purposes of:

(i) Giving the act of the regular session of the Ninety-Third General Assembly its full force and effect; and

(ii) Amending or repealing the appropriate parts of the Arkansas Code of 1987; and

(B) Section 1-2-107 shall not apply; and

(3) This act shall make only technical, not substantive, changes to the Arkansas Code of 1987.
