20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE	GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22	SECTION 1. APP	ROPRIATION - DIVISION OF AGRICULTURE. There is hereby
23	appropriated, to the	University of Arkansas, to be payable from the cash
24	funds as defined by	Arkansas Code 19-4-801, for construction, renovation,
25	maintenance, equipme	nt, personal services and operating expenses of the
26	University of Arkans	as - Division of Agriculture for the fiscal year ending
27	June 30, 2022, the s	um of\$16,500,000.
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29	SECTION 2. SPE	CIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
30	CODE NOR PUBLISHED S	EPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PINE TREE
31	RESEARCH STATION.	
32	<u>(a) The Board</u>	of Trustees of the University of Arkansas shall not sell
33	the property commonl	y known as the Pine Tree Research Station, located in St.
34	Francis County, Arka	nsas, which was acquired by the Board of Trustees of the
35	University of Arkans	as from the United States of America acting through the
36	Forest Service in 19	78, to a private entity or individual.

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1	(b) The Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas may sell the
2	property commonly known as the Pine Tree Research Station, located in St.
3	Francis County, Arkansas, which was acquired by the Board of Trustees of the
4	University of Arkansas from the United States of America acting through the
5	Forest Service in 1978, to:
6	(1) A non-profit corporation organized with the primary mission
7	to keep the land open to the public and available for public use; and
8	(2) Organized and operated for a minimum of five (5) years.
9	(c) The property commonly known as the Pine Tree Research Station,
10	located in St. Francis County, Arkansas, which was acquired by the Board of
11	Trustees of the University of Arkansas from the United States of America
12	acting through the Forest Service in 1978, shall remain open to the public
13	for public use, including without limitation:
14	(1) Public fishing;
15	(2) Public hunting;
16	<u>(3) Biking;</u>
17	(4) Bird watching; and
18	(5) Hiking.
19	(d) All property commonly known as the Pine Tree Research Station,
20	located in St. Francis County, Arkansas, which was acquired by the Board of
21	Trustees of the University of Arkansas from the United States of America
22	acting through the Forest Service in 1978, in row crop cultivation in the
23	year 2020 is exempt from subsection (c) of this section.
24	The provisions of this section shall be in effect upon passage and
25	approval through June 30, 2022.
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27	SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
28	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
29	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
30	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
31	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
32	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
33	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
34	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
35	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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1	SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
2	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
3	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
4	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
5	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
6	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
7	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
8	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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10	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
11	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
12	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided; with the
15	exception that Section 2 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from
16	and after the date of its passage and approval, and that in the event of an
17	extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act
18	beyond July 1, 2021, with the exception that Section 2 in this Act shall be
19	in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval,
20	could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of
21	essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared
22	to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
23	public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
24	after July 1, 2021; with the exception that Section 2 in this Act shall be in
25	full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
