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27	SECTION 1. Arkansas	Code § 6-85-204, concerning	ng definitions under the

34	SECTION 2. Arkansas	Code § 6-85-206(3)(A), cor	ncerning admission as a
35	full-time or part-time student to be eligible for the Arkansas Academic		
36	Challenge Scholarship Prog	ram, is amended to read as	follows:

1	(3)(A) The applicant is accepted for admission as a full-time		
2	student or part-time student at:		
3	(i) An At an approved institution of higher		
4	education in a program of study that leads to or is creditable toward:		
5	(a) A baccalaureate degree;		
6	(b) An associate degree;		
7	(c) A certificate from a qualified certificate		
8	program; or		
9	(d) A graduate-level or professional degree;

11	(ii) An At an approved school of nursing in a		
12	program of study that leads to a nursing diploma under § 6-85-213; or		
13	(iii) In a comprehensive transition and		
14	postsecondary program.

16	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-85-210(a)(1), concerning continuing		
17	eligibility criteria for an Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship, is		
18	amended to read as follows:		
19	(a)(l)(A) A recipient who meets continuing eligibility criteria under		
20	this subchapter shall receive a scholarship for one (1) academic year		
21	renewable annually until the recipient has earned one hundred twenty (120)		
22	semester credit hours or has received a scholarship under this subchapter for		
23	eight (8) semesters, whichever occurs first.		
24	(B)(i) A recipient may continue to receive a scholarship		
25	after he or she has earned one hundred twenty (120) semester credit hours,		
26	but not more than one hundred thirty (130) semester credit hours, if the		
27	student is enrolled in a baccalaureate degree program that requires more than		
28	one hundred twenty (120) semester credit hours as provided under $\S$ 6-61-232.		
29	(ii) The Division of Higher Education, in		
30	conjunction with the approved institution of higher education at which the		
31	recipient is enrolled, shall determine the maximum period for renewal of a		
32	scholarship under this subchapter.		
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34	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 85, Subchapter 2, is amended		
35	to add an additional section to read as follows:		

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6-85-222. Additional eligibility requirements for Comprehensive

- 1 Transition and Postsecondary Program student.
- 2 (a) In addition to the requirements of § 6-85-206, an applicant is
- 3 <u>eligible for an Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship as a Comprehensive</u>
- 4 Transition and Postsecondary Program student if the applicant has:
- 5 (1) Completed high school in an Arkansas high school in
- 6 accordance with the requirements of the applicant's individualized education
- 7 program under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. §
- 8 1400 et seq. or accommodations made for the applicant under section 504 of
- 9 the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, 29 U.S.C. § 794; and
- 10 (2) Been accepted for admission to and enrolled in an approved
- 11 institution of higher education eligible program of study within thirty-six
- 12 (36) months of completing high school.
- 13 <u>(b) To maintain eligibility for an Arkansas Academic Challenge</u>
- 14 <u>Scholarship under this section</u>, a recipient shall:
- 15 <u>(1) Maintain continual enrollment in the approved institution of</u>
- 16 <u>higher education eligible program of study in which the recipient is</u>
- 17 <u>enrolled; and</u>
- 18 (2) Make satisfactory academic progress in the approved
- 19 <u>institution of higher education eligible program of study in which the</u>
- 20 recipient is enrolled.
- 21 (c)(1) A scholarship under this section shall be renewed until the
- 22 recipient:
- 23 (A) Earns a bachelor's degree; or
- 24 (B) Attempts a total of one hundred thirty (130) semester
- 25 <u>hours within eight (8) semesters.</u>
- 26 (2) If the recipient's eligible program of study under this
- 27 section requires more than one hundred thirty (130) semester credit hours to
- 28 complete, the Division of Higher Education, in conjunction with the approved
- 29 <u>institution of higher education program at which the recipient is enrolled</u>,
- 30 <u>shall determine the maximum period for renewal of a scholarship under</u>
- 31 <u>subdivision (c)(1) of this section.</u>
- 32 (d) A recipient of a scholarship under this section who loses
- 33 eligibility for the scholarship is not eligible to reapply to receive the
- 34 scholarship.
- 35 (e)(1) The division may approve a scholarship hold for a Comprehensive
- 36 Transition and Postsecondary Program student for the following reasons:

1	(A) A medical condition of the student or a member of the		
2	student's immediate family that, on the basis of a physician's good-faith		
3	judgment, necessitates the student or the student's immediate family member		
4	to be hospitalized or receive outpatient or home-based medical care or to		
5	recuperate until released by the attending physician; or		
6	(B) A personal or family emergency that requires the		
7	student to:		
8	(i) Attend the funeral of an immediate family		
9	member; or		
10	(ii) Visit a relative of the student if the relative		
11	has a medical condition in which death is possible or imminent.		
12	(2) A student who is approved for a scholarship hold under		
13	subdivision (e)(1) of this section shall maintain eligibility requirements		
14	under this section and § 6-85-206 in order to be eligible for a scholarship		
15	hold.		
16	(f) A scholarship granted to a Comprehensive Transition and		
17	Postsecondary Program student under this section shall be applied to only one		
18	(1) approved institution of higher education at a time.		
19	(g) As used in this section:		
20	(1) "Approved institution of higher education program" means		
21	only the following programs within institutions of higher education:		
22	(A) Arkansas State University - H.O.W.L. Transition		
23	Program;		
24	(B) South Arkansas Community College — Academic and Career		
25	Achievement Program;		
26	(C) University of Arkansas — EMPOWER Program; and		
27	(D) University of Arkansas — Pulaski Technical College —		
28	3D Program;		
29	(2) "Eligible program of study" means a postsecondary program		
30	that:		
31	(A) Has received the Comprehensive Transition and		
32	Postsecondary Program designation from the United States Department of		
33	Education;		
34	(B) Is offered by an approved institution of higher		
35	education that assists students with disabilities who have completed high		
36	school and who need a system of education and support services to access and		

1	obtain postsecondary education; and		
2	(C) Includes an individualized program of study for up to		
3	four (4) years that is designed to provide postsecondary activities on		
4	campus, including without limitation:		
5	(i) Academic activities;		
6	<pre>(ii) Career development;</pre>		
7	(iii) Career exploration; and		
8	(iv) Independent living skills; and		
9	(3) "Student with a disability" means an individual:		
10	(A) Has a cognitive impairment characterized by		
11	significant limitations in:		
12	(i) Intellectual and cognitive functioning; or		
13	(ii) Adaptive behavior as expressed in the following		
14	skills:		
15	(a) Conceptual skills;		
16	(b) Social skills; or		
17	(c) Practical adaptive skills;		
18	(B) Is currently, or was formerly, eligible for special		
19	education and related services under the Individuals with Disabilities		
20	Education Act, 20 U.S.C., § 1400 et seq., including a student who was		
21	determined to be eligible for special education or related services under the		
22	Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C., § 1400 et seq., but		
23	was home-schooled or attended private school; and		
24	(C) Maintains an acceptable standing within the		
25	Comprehensive Transition and Postsecondary Program that is evaluated by		
26	standards set forth in 34 CFR § 668.230 et seq. and the approved institution		
27	of higher education program in which the student is enrolled.		
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
