24	SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Legislative intent.</u>			
25	The General Ass	embly finds that:		
26	(1) The services provided by freight railroads are essential to			
27	the functionality of the state during a national pandemic; and			
28	(2) It is necessary to grant the Department of Health			
29	jurisdiction of oversight to maintain safe working conditions for railroad			
30	employees and the cit	<u>izens of Arkansas.</u>

32	SECTION $2$ . Title 23, Chapter 12, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an			
33	additional section to read as follows:			
34	23-12-106. National pandemic safety guideline enforcement —			
35	<u>Definitions.</u>			
36	(a) As used in	this section:

1	(1)(A) "Railroad" means any form of nonhighway ground		
2	transportation that runs on rails or electromagnetic guideways within this		
3	state, including without limitation:		
4	(i) Commuter railroad service or other short-haul		
5	railroad passenger service in a metropolitan area; or		
6	(ii) High-speed ground transportation systems that		
7	connect metropolitan areas, without regard to whether those systems use new		
8	technologies not associated with traditional railroads.		
9	(B) "Railroad" does not include rapid transit operations		
10	in a metropolitan area that are not connected to the general railroad system		
11	of transportation.		
12	(b)(1) In the event of a national pandemic declared by the Centers for		
13	Disease Control and Prevention, a railroad operating in the state shall		
14	comply with the workplace guidelines provided by the Centers for Disease		
15	Control and Prevention.		
16	(2) The Department of Health shall enforce the workplace		
17	guidelines provided by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention under		
18	subdivision (b)(1) of this section.		
19			
20	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
21	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that maintaining safe operating		
22	practices by railroad carriers is necessary for public safety and commerce		
23	efficiency; that allowing the Department of Health to enforce pandemic safety		
24	standards will ensure the safety of the citizens of this state by helping to		
25	alleviate and avoid consequences that can damage the state's infrastructure;		
26	and that this act conveys the importance of transportation infrastructure,		
27	uninterrupted commerce, and the state's duty to protect its citizens.		
28	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately		
29	necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety shall		
30	become effective on:		
31	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
32	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
33	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
34	<pre>bill; or</pre>		
35	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
36	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
