6	the county court shall call a special election in accordance with § 7-11-201
7	et seq. upon the first levy of the tax by the county quorum court, to be held
8	not more than ninety (90) days from the date of the adoption of the levy of
9	the tax by the quorum court on the next special election date under § 7-11-
10	205, at which <u>election</u> the qualified electors of the area to be affected by
11	the tax shall vote on the question of the levy of the tax.
12	
13	SECTION 40. Arkansas Code § 26-78-111(c), concerning the requirement
14	for an election on the question of issuing revenue bonds, is amended to read
15	as follows:
16	(c) The ordinance or order shall specifically state the purpose for
17	which the bonds are to be issued, the total amount of the issue, and the date
18	upon which the election is to be held, which date shall not occur earlier
19	than thirty (30) days after the passage of the ordinance or the entering of
20	the order be on the next special election date under § 7-11-205.
