14	(3) The clerk of the circuit court; or	
15	(4) A justice of the peace.	
16	(3) The oath shall be filed in the office of the county clerk	
17	and <u>the county clerk shall forward</u> a duplicate <del>forwarded</del> to the Secretary of	
18	State.

20	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 7-4-107(b)(2)(B), concerning the duties of	
21	the county board of election commissioners, is amended to read as follows:	
22	(B)(i) The election judge shall serve as the poll	
23	supervisor.	
24	(ii) No election judge shall serve in the same	
25	precinct as a spouse, parent, stepparent, child, stepchild, sibling, or	
26	stepsibling, unless they serve on separate shifts that do not run	
27	concurrently or in other duties as assigned unless approved by the county	
28	board of election commissioners.	
29		
30	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 7-4-107, concerning the duties of the	
31	county board of election commissioners, is amended to add an additional	
32	subsection to read as follows:	
33	(d) A county board of election commissioners may enact policies	
34	pursuant to the official duties of the county board of election commissioners	
35	under Arkansas law.

1	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 7-4-109(a), concerning the qualifications	
2	of state and county commissioners, election officials, poll workers, and	
3	certified election monitors, is amended to add an additional subdivision to	
4	read as follows:	
5	(4) Candidates, members of a candidate's immediate family to the	
6	second degree of kinship by affinity or consanguinity, and any member of a	
7	candidate's principal campaign committee are ineligible for appointment	
8	unless otherwise exempted by the county board of election commissioners.	
9		
10	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 7-4-109(b)(2), concerning the	
11	qualifications of state and county commissioners, election officials, poll	
12	workers, and certified election monitors, is amended to read as follows:	
13	(2)(A) An election official shall be a resident of the precinct	
14	county in which he or she serves at the time of his or her appointment.	
15	(B) However, if at the time of posting election officials	
16	the county board of election commissioners votes unanimously and certifies to	
17	the county clerk that it is impossible to obtain a qualified election	
18	official from any precinct in the county, another qualified citizen of the	
19	county may be designated to serve in the precinct.	
20	(C) An election coordinator, deputy clerk, or person	
21	assigned by a county clerk, or person assigned by the county board of	
22	<u>election commissioners</u> to conduct early voting does not have to be a resident	
23	of the precinct or county in which he or she serves.	
24		
25	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 7-4-109(c)(2), concerning the	
26	qualifications of state and county commissioners, election officials, poll	
27	workers, and certified election monitors, is amended to read as follows:	
28	(2)(A) Except as provided in subdivision $(c)(2)(B)$ of this	
29	section, a person serving on the county board of election commissioners shall	
30	not participate in the campaign of any candidate listed on a ballot or of a	
31	write-in candidate seeking election in that county that falls under the	
32	county board of election commissioners' jurisdiction or authority <u>if a person</u>	
33	<u>is:</u>	
34	(i) Serving on the county board of election	
35	<pre>commissioners;</pre>	
36	(ii) Designated as county election staff;	

1	(iii) A deputy county clerk;		
2	(iv) A temporary employee of the county clerk		
3	working on election matters;		
4	(v) Serving as a county election coordinator; or		
5	(vi)(a) A county clerk.		
6	(b) A county clerk is eligible to participate		
7	in a campaign if the county clerk is a candidate.		
8	(B)(i) A member of the county board of election		
9	commissioners person who shall not participate in the campaign of any		
10	candidate identified in subdivision (c)(2)(A) of this section shall not:		
11	(a) Manage a campaign;		
12	(b) Perform labor for a campaign;		
13	(c) Solicit on behalf of a candidate or		
14	campaign;		
15	(d) Pass out or place handbills, signs, or

32	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 7-4-109(d), concerning the qualifications		
33	of state and county commissioners, election officials, poll workers, and		
34	certified election monitors, are amended to read as follows:		
35	(d) A person shall not serve as an election official if:		
36	(1) The person is married to or related within the second degree		

1	of consanguinity to a candidate running for office in the election; and	
2	(2) The spouse of a member of a county board of election	
3	<pre>commissioners;</pre>	
4	(3) A county party chair or his or her spouse;	
5	(4) Another person makes an objection to his or her service to	
6	the county board of election commissioners within ten (10) calendar days	
7	after posting the list of officials.	
8		
9	SECTION 8. Arkansas Code $\S$ 7-4-109(e)(1)(C) and (D), concerning the	
10	qualifications of state and county commissioners, election officials, poll	
11	workers, and certified election monitors, are amended to read as follows:	
12	(C) A poll worker; and	
13	(D) A certified election monitor; and	
14	(E) A county election coordinator.	
15		
16	SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 7-4-109(e), concerning the qualifications	
17	of state and county commissioners, election officials, poll workers, and	
18	certified election monitors, is amended to add additional subdivisions to	
19	read as follows:	
20	(4)(A) A county board of election commissioners by a majority	
21	vote shall designate a person to attend the required training as a county	
22	election coordinator.	
23	(B) The State Board of Election Commissioners shall not	
24	provide training or compensation for attending training to a county election	
25	coordinator if the county election coordinator has not been designated by a	
26	county board of election commissioners.	
27	(5)(A) The State Board of Election Commissioners shall identify	
28	at least one (1) person each year, who shall receive the same training as a	
29	county election coordinator, and who shall receive compensation for attending	
30	training.	
31	(B) The person identified by the State Board of Election	
32	Commissioners may be a state employee being cross-trained, or a person who is	
33	not a state employee that the State Board of Election Commissioners considers	
34	qualified to become an acting county election coordinator as a special	
35	employee of the State Board of Election Commissioners.	

1	SECTION 10. Arkansas Code § /-5-202(a)(2), concerning service as an
2	election official, deputy county clerk, or additional deputy, is repealed.
3	(2)(A) A person shall not serve as an election official if:
4	(i) The person is:
5	(i) Married to or related within the second degree
6	of consanguinity to a candidate running for office in the election;
7	(ii) The spouse of a member of a county board of
8	election commissioners; or
9	(iii) A county party chair or his or her spouse; and
10	(B) Another person makes an objection to his or her
11	service to the county board of election commissioners within ten (10)
12	calendar days after posting the list of officials.
13	
14	SECTION 11. Arkansas Code § 7-5-414(b), concerning the qualifications
15	and appointment of election clerks, is amended to add additional subdivisions
16	to read as follows:
17	(3) No election clerk shall serve in the same precinct as a
18	spouse, parent, stepparent, child, stepchild, sibling, or stepsibling, unless
19	they serve on separate shifts that do not run concurrently or in other duties
20	as assigned unless approved by the county board of election commissioners.
21	(4)(A) Election clerks working in groups of two shall not be
22	from the same political party.
23	(B) If an election clerk with a political affiliation that
24	is the same as a political party represented on the county board of election
25	commissioners is unavailable, the county board of election commissioners
26	shall select an election clerk without party affiliation, with the party
27	affiliation of a new political party, or with the party affiliation of
28	another political party not represented on the county board of election
29	commissioners.
30	(C) The county board of election commissioners may approve
31	alternate election clerks that do not meet the requirements of subdivisions
32	(b)(4)(A) and (B) of this section by a majority vote of the county board of
33	election commissioners.
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
