29	(a) An institution shall not accept a gift from a foreign source or		
30	enter into a contract with a foreign source if the institution believes that		
31	doing so would threaten:		
32	(1) The integrity of the institution's research, instruction, or		
33	operations;		
34	(2) The institution's intellectual property rights;		
35	(3) The protection of confidential information; or		
36	(4) The safety and security of:		

1	(A) The institution;	
2	(B) The institution's personnel and students;	
3	(C) This state; or	
4	(D) The United States.	
5	(b) If an institution receives a gift from a foreign source valued at	
6	more than two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000), the institution	
7	shall disclose the following information without limitation with respect to	
8	the gift:	
9	(1) The dollar value of the gift;	
10	(2) The name and national affiliation of the foreign source	
11	funding the gift;	
12	(3) The department, college, school, or other business unit of	
13	the institution to which the gift was made;	
14	(4) The date the gift was received; and	
15	(5) A brief description of the gift.	
16	(c) If an institution enters into a contract with a foreign source	
17	valued at more than two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000), the	
18	institution shall disclose the following information without limitation with	
19	respect to the contract:	
20	(1) The dollar value of the contract;	
21	(2) The name and national affiliation of the foreign source	
22	entering into the contract with the institution;	
23	(3) The department, college, school, or other business unit of	
24	the institution that benefits from the contract;	
25	(4) The effective date and termination date of the contract; and	
26	(5) A brief description of the terms of the contract.	
27	(d) If an institution receives multiple gifts from foreign sources	
28	affiliated with the same foreign government and each of the gifts is valued	
29	at two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) or less, but the aggregate	
30	value of the gifts is more than two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000)	
31	the institution shall disclose each of the gifts as required under subsection	
32	(b) of this section.	
33	(e) If an institution enters into multiple contracts with foreign	
34	sources affiliated with the same foreign government and each of the contracts	
35	is valued at two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) or less but the	
36	aggregate value of the contracts is more two hundred fifty thousand dollars	

1	(\$250,000), the institution shall disclose each of the contracts as required		
2	under subsection (c) of this section.

4	6-60-1205. Gifts and contracts — Annual disclosure report.		
5	(a) By July 31, 2021, and by July 31 of each year thereafter, each		
6	institution shall prepare a gifts and contracts disclosure report that		
7	includes the information required under § 6-60-1204 regarding gifts from		
8	foreign sources and contracts entered into with foreign sources.		
9	(b) The annual gifts and contracts disclosure report required under		
10	subsection (a) of this section shall:		
11	(1) Be submitted to the:		
12	(A) Secretary of the Department of Finance and		
13	Administration; and		
14	(B) Department of Public Safety; and		
15	(2) Disclose the gifts received from foreign sources and		
16	contracts entered into with foreign sources during the fiscal year ending on		
17	June 30 immediately preceding the reporting deadline under subsection (a) of		
18	this section.		
19	(c) If an institution does not have a gift or contract subject to the		
20	disclosure reporting requirement under subsection (a) of this section, the		
21	institution shall submit a gifts and contracts disclosure report stating that		
22	the institution does not have a gift from a foreign source or a contract		
23	entered into with a foreign source subject to disclosure.		
24	(d) The secretary shall make the gifts and contracts disclosure		
25	reports required under this section publicly available on the website of the		
26	Department of Finance and Administration.		
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28	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
29	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Chinese Communist Party		
30	has already been found to have placed spies in institutions of higher		
31	education in this state; that it is necessary to preserve the state's		
32	security and ensure transparency in the actions taken by state-supported		
33	institutions of higher education; and that this act is immediately necessary		
34	before the upcoming academic year in order to prohibit certain contracts and		
35	gifts that may be entered into or received during the upcoming academic year.		
36	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately		

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1	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall			
2	become effective on:			
3	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;			
4	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by	the Governor,		
5	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor	may veto the		
6	bill; or			
7	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the	veto is		
8	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
