| 6 | participating ambulatory surgery centers converted to hospitals under the |
| 7 | Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' Hospitals Without Walls initiative |
| 8 | and other Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services-certified facility |
| 9 | flexibilities; that by providing legislative clarity concerning the |
| 10 | regulatory authority of the Department of Health the uncertainty will |
| 11 | resolved and the continued operation of participating ambulatory surgery |
| 12 | centers converted to hospitals under the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid |
| 13 | Services' Hospitals Without Walls initiative and other Centers for Medicare $\&$ |
| 14 | Medicaid Services-certified facility flexibilities can continue; and that |
| 15 | this act is immediately necessary to protect the public health and safety in |
| 16 | order to provide legislative clarity for the Department of Health's |
| 17 | regulatory authority concerning the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' |
