32 (c)(1) It is the intent of the Ninety-Second General Assembly that the 33 authority under this section to transfer positions is intended for use for the 34 time period prior to Fiscal Year 2022 2023 to allow cabinet-level departments 35 to establish a centralized Regular Salaries - Shared Services section, with 36 the recommendation that the position transfer authority granted under this

1 section be discontinued after that time.

2 (2) The Bureau of Legislative Research shall bring the 3 recommendation in subdivision (c)(1) of this section to the attention of the 4 chairs conducting the <u>2021 2022 Regular Fiscal Session pre-session budget</u> 5 hearings, the chairs of the Special Language Subcommittee, and the members of 6 the Special Language Subcommittee during pre-session budget hearings.

7 (d) Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount 8 of appropriation and general revenue funding for a cabinet-level department 9 each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually 10 accomplished by delineating the maximums in the appropriation act or acts and 11 establishing authorized positions and the general revenue allocations 12 authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue 13 Stabilization Law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that the 14 cabinet-level departments created under Acts 2019, No. 910, may operate more 15 efficiently if some flexibility is provided as authorized under this section. 16 Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly 17 maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or, 18 if the General Assembly is in session, the Joint Budget Committee, as 19 provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative 20 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. 21 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 22 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, 23 this entire section is void.

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27 SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 28 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 29 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 30 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 33 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

1 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 2 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 3 4 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 5 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 6 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 7 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 8 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 9 10 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the

11	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
12	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
15	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
16	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm
17	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
18	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
19	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
20	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.
