30	This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the "Arkansas Federal		
31	Firearm, Magazine, and Amm	unition Ban Enforcement Pro	hibition Act of 2021".

34	This chapter is enacted under the authority of the Second Amendment and		
35	Tenth Amendment to the Uni	ted States Constitution, Ar	kansas Constitution,

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2	1-6-103. Definitions.		
3	As used in this chapter:		
4	(1) "Federal ban" means a federal law, executive order, rule, or		
5	regulation that is enacted, adopted, or becomes effective on or after January		
6	1, 2021, that infringes upon, calls into question, or prohibits, restricts,		
7	or requires individual licensure for or registration of the purchase,		
8	ownership, possession, transfer, or use of any firearm, any magazine or othe		
9	ammunition feeding device, or other firearm accessory; and		
10	(2) "Firearm" means a self-loading rifle, pistol, revolver, or		
11	shotgun, or any manually loaded rifle, pistol, revolver, or shotgun.		
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13	1-6-104. Prohibition of enforcement.		
14	(a) A state law enforcement officer, state employee, or employee of a		
15	political subdivision of the state is prohibited from enforcing, assisting in		
16	the enforcement of, or otherwise cooperating in the enforcement of a federal		
17	ban and is also prohibited from participating in any federal enforcement		
18	action implementing a federal ban.		
19	(b) An employee of the state or a political subdivision of the state		
20	shall not expend public funds or allocate public resources for the		
21	enforcement of a federal ban.		
22	(c) This section shall not be construed to prohibit or otherwise limit		
23	a state law enforcement officer, state employee, or employee of a political		
24	subdivision of the state from cooperating, communicating, or collaborating		
25	with a federal agency if the primary purpose is not:		
26	(1) Law enforcement activity related to a federal ban; or		
27	(2) The investigation of a violation of a federal ban.		
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
