(B) As used in subdivision (b)(2)(A) of this section, "immediate family member" means a spouse, child, parent, brother, sister, grandchild, or grandparent of the individual; (3)(A) Due to domestic violence that causes the individual reasonably to believe that the individual's continued employment will jeopardize the safety of the individual or a member of the individual's immediate family. (B) As used in subdivision (b)(3)(A) of this section, "immediate family member" means a spouse, child, parent, brother, sister, grandchild, or grandparent of the individual; or (4) To accompany the individual's spouse because of a change in the location of the spouse's employment that makes it impractical to commute; or (5) Due to a refusal by the individual to be vaccinated against coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) or its variants. SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 11-10-514, concerning disqualification for unemployment benefits generally due to discharge for misconduct, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows: (d) An individual shall not be disqualified for benefits if he or she is terminated solely due to a refusal to be vaccinated against coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) or its variants.
