Arkansas Code § 11-10-514, concerning disqualification for 19 unemployment benefits generally due to discharge for misconduct, is amended 20 to add an additional subsection to read as follows: 21 (d) An individual shall not be disqualified for benefits if he or she 22 is terminated solely due to a refusal to be vaccinated against coronavirus 23 2019 (COVID-19) or its variants. 24 25 SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that employees in Arkansas are 26 27 being terminated solely due to a refusal to be vaccinated against coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19); that the termination leaves these employees with no income 28 29 to support themselves and their families; and that immediate action is necessary in order to protect Arkansas employees from the effects of these 30 vaccination mandates. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 31 32 act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, 33 health, and safety shall become effective on: (1) The date of its approval by the Governor; 34 35 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,

36 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the

2	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
3	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
