           SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
    General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the General Assembly is

    responsible for establishing the four (4) United States Congressional

    United States Bureau of the Census; that the federal decennial census data

    citizens of Arkansas in the United States Congress; and that this act is

     immediately necessary because the establishment of the four (4) United States

    Congressional Districts must occur in adequate time for the candidates to

    file for office and for the citizens of Arkansas to have a fair election.
