(B) The consumer representative representatives under subdivision (b)(4)(A) (b)(3)(A) of this section shall not be actively engaged in or retired from the practice of dispensing hearing instruments. (C) The consumer representative representatives under subdivision (b)(4)(A) (b)(3)(A) of this section shall be a full voting member but shall not participate in the grading of examinations. SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-84-202(b), concerning the organization and proceedings of the Arkansas Board of Hearing Instrument Dispensers, is amended to read as follows: (b)(1) Any five (5) of the eight (8) A majority of the members of the board, when properly convened, may conduct business of the board. (2) The board may appoint one (1) or more of its members or any other person it deems appropriate as examiners for the purpose of hearing evidence, reporting findings thereon, and making recommendations to the entire board for a decision on any matter over which the board has authority.
