15 TO AMEND THE COMPOSITION OF THE ARKANSAS
16 BOARD OF HEARING INSTRUMENT DISPENSERS.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-84-201(b), concerning the creation and
22 composition of the Arkansas Board of Hearing Instrument Dispensers, is
23 amended to read as follows:

24 (b) The board shall be composed of seven (7) members appointed by the
25 Governor, subject to confirmation by the Senate, for terms of three (3) years
26 as follows:

27 (1)(A) At least four (4) of the members shall be hearing
28 instrument dispensers licensed under this chapter who have held a valid
29 license for at least three (3) years.

30 (B) The Governor shall consult the Arkansas Hearing
31 Society, Inc., before making an appointment under subdivision (b)(1)(A) of
32 this section;

33 ~~(2) At least one (1) member shall be a physician licensed to~~
34 ~~practice medicine in Arkansas and specializing in otology or otolaryngology;~~

35 ~~(3)~~(2) At least one (1) member shall be an audiologist holding a
36 master's degree or doctoral degree in audiology from a recognized college or



1 university; and

2 ~~(4)(A)~~(3)(A) ~~One (1) member~~ Two (2) members shall be appointed
3 from the state at large to represent consumers.

4 (B) The consumer ~~representative~~ representatives under
5 subdivision ~~(b)(4)(A)~~ (b)(3)(A) of this section shall not be actively engaged
6 in or retired from the practice of dispensing hearing instruments.

7 (C) The consumer ~~representative~~ representatives under
8 subdivision ~~(b)(4)(A)~~ (b)(3)(A) of this section shall be a full voting member
9 but shall not participate in the grading of examinations.

11 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-84-202(b), concerning the organization
12 and proceedings of the Arkansas Board of Hearing Instrument Dispensers, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 ~~(b)(1) Any five (5) of the eight (8)~~ A majority of the members of the
15 board, when properly convened, may conduct business of the board.

16 (2) The board may appoint one (1) or more of its members or any
17 other person it deems appropriate as examiners for the purpose of hearing
18 evidence, reporting findings thereon, and making recommendations to the
19 entire board for a decision on any matter over which the board has authority.
