19 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. INDIGENT 20 21 PARENT COUNSEL REPRESENTATION. The Commission for Parent Counsel shall have 22 the authority to use the appropriation provided in line item Parent Counsel 23 Reimbursements of the Parent Counsel Program appropriation herein for the 24 purpose of entering into independent professional service contracts on a 25 full-time or part-time basis with attorneys who are qualified to provide 26 counsel for indigent parents in dependency-neglect cases.

27 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020
28 <u>2021</u> through June 30, 2021 <u>2022</u>.

29

30 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 32 PROVISION - LINE ITEMS - COMMISSION FOR PARENT COUNSEL. After receiving 33 approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review by the 34 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the 35 Arkansas Public Defender Commission is authorized to transfer appropriation, 36 with the exception of Personal Services Matching, between the line items authorized herein for the Commission for Parent Counsel, to best utilize
 resources to meet the needs of the Parent Counsel's clientele.
 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020
 2021 through June 30, 2021 2022.

6 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA 8 HELP EXEMPTION - COMMISSION FOR PARENT COUNSEL. Extra Help positions 9 authorized herein for the Commission for Parent Counsel are specifically 10 exempt from limitation of hours. Employees currently working on a part-time 11 basis may be utilized concurrently as Extra Help within the agency. The 12 total amount of compensation for part-time and Extra Help work combined 13 cannot exceed the maximum compensation allowed for a grade GS11 as authorized 14 in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. Flexibility is needed to 15 allow for non-traditional work schedules that may be necessary to accommodate 16 the schedule of the individual being represented. Attorneys utilized as 17 Extra Help employees are not prevented from having other employment. 18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020 19 2021 through June 30, 2021 2022.

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SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER PROVISION. If the Public Defender Commission should determine that the appropriations made available for payments to the Counties are insufficient, appropriation may be transferred from the Public Defender Commission Program line item to the Bail Bond-County Public Defender line item, after receiving approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2020}{2021}$ through June 30, $\frac{2021}{2022}$.

31 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PUBLIC 33 DEFENDERS. (a) No funds appropriated herein shall be used for expenses in 34 cases where a defendant is represented by retained counsel where retained 35 counsel have not gone through the Public Defender Commission's attorney 36 certification procedure and designation process as established by state law and the Commission's regulations. All defendants and retained attorneys must
 strictly adhere to the procedure established by the Commission to equitably
 and responsibly monitor and distribute State funds for this purpose.

4 (b) The Public Defender Commission may approve exemptions to subsection
5 (a) as needed. Reasons for granting exemption should be specified in writing.
6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020
7 <u>2021</u> through June 30, 2021 2022.

8

9 SECTION 17. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 10 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 11 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 12 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 15 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 16 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

18

19 SECTION 18. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 21 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 22 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 27

28

SECTION 19. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the

General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 29 30 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of 31 32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 33 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 34 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm 35 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 36 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
