There is hereby authorized, for 9 the Office of the Governor for the 2021-2022 fiscal year, the following 10 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra 11 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: seven (7) 12 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed 13 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its 14 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification. 15 16 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. APPROPRIATION - GOVERNOR'S EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION. There is 35 hereby appropriated, to the Office of the Governor, to be payable from the 36 Miscellaneous Revolving Fund, for the purpose provided by Arkansas Code 19-2-

7 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 9 PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 10 State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 11 Committee, the Agency is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line 12 item authorized in Operations Appropriation of the Governor's Office in this 13 Act to any other line item authorized in Operations Appropriation.

14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020 15 <u>2021</u> through June 30, 2021 <u>2022</u>.

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17 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARIES. 19 In order that exceptionally well-qualified personnel may be recruited and 20 retained, the Office of the Governor may exceed the maximum salary levels by 21 no more than twenty percent (20%) for no more than one-third (1/3) of the 22 positions authorized in the operation appropriation act after receiving 23 approval from the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. 24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020 25 2021 through June 30, 2021 2022.

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27 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 28 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 29 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 30 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 33 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.
