18	WHEREAS, service to others is a hallmark of the American character, and
19	throughout our history citizens have stepped up to meet our challenges by
20	volunteering in their communities; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, AmeriCorps provides opportunities for nearly seventy-five
23	thousand (75,000) Americans each year to serve their country through an
24	intensive commitment to service at nonprofits, schools, public agencies, and
25	community and faith-based groups across the country; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, AmeriCorps enriches the lives of its members, building habits
28	that create engaged citizens who are active participants in civic matters
29	affecting their communities long after their service terms are completed; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, AmeriCorps members encourage collaboration and partnerships,
32	leveraging millions of volunteers in service and acquiring the support of
33	business partners to increase the effectiveness of their initiatives; and
34	INTERESC. The 2010 2020 county of the county
35	WHEREAS, the 2019-2020 annual state report reflects that in Arkansas
36	more than three thousand three hundred (3,300) AmeriCorps members of various



1	ages and backgrounds helped to meet local needs at more than three hundred
2	(300) locations in the state by tutoring or mentoring children and youth,
3	restoring the environment, increasing food security, and responding to
4	disasters; and
5	
6	WHEREAS, in exchange for their service, AmeriCorps members develop
7	valuable work skills, earn money for continuing education, and strengthen the
8	lives of their families, their communities, and the state as a whole; and
9	
10	WHEREAS, since AmeriCorps was founded in 1993, more than ten thousand
11	(10,000) residents in Arkansas have served approximately sixteen million
12	(16,000,000) hours through AmeriCorps and have received higher education and
13	loan reimbursement from the Segal AmeriCorps Education Award totaling more
14	than thirty million dollars (\$30,000,000); and
15	
16	WHEREAS, AmeriCorps Week is an opportunity to recognize the dedication
17	and commitment of the more than one million (1,000,000) Americans who have
18	chosen to serve their country through AmeriCorps and their community
19	partners, and to encourage more Americans to follow their footsteps in
20	service,

22	NOW THEREFORE,
23	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
24	STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

27	the week of March 7-13, 2021, as AmeriCorps Week in Arkansas.
