33	MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

35	That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
36	the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state

1 for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives 2 and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election 3 adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of 4 the State of Arkansas, to wit: 5 6 SECTION 1. Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, Section 19, is amended to 7 read as follows: 8 § 19. Extraordinary sessions of General Assembly - Calling - Purposes. 9 (a) The Governor may, by proclamation, on extraordinary occasions, 10 convene the General Assembly at the seat of government, or at a different 11 place, if that shall have become, since their last adjournment, dangerous 12 from an enemy or contagious disease; and he shall specify in his proclamation 13 the purpose for which they are convened; and no other business than that set 14 forth therein shall be transacted until the same shall have been disposed of; 15 after which they may, by a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to 16 both houses, entered upon their journals, remain in session not exceeding 17 fifteen days. 18 (b)(1) If the Governor declares by executive order or proclamation 19 that an emergency exists in the state, he or she shall convene the General 20 Assembly in extraordinary session within twenty-four (24) hours of the 21 declaration of the emergency. 22 (2)(A) Except as provided under subdivision (b)(2)(B) of this 23 section, the purpose of an extraordinary session under subdivision (b)(1) of this section shall be the consideration of legislation related to the 24 25 emergency declared by the Governor. 26 (B) During an extraordinary session under subdivision 27 (b)(1) of this section, the General Assembly may take administrative action regarding the executive head of a state agency, including without limitation: 28 29 (i) Terminating the employment of the executive head 30 of the state agency; and 31 (ii) Hiring an individual to serve as the executive 32 head of the state agency. 33 (3)(A) The extraordinary session shall: 34 (i) Continue for the duration of the emergency declared by the Governor; and 35 36 (ii) Adjourn sine die upon the termination of the

1	emergency declaration.
2	(B) The General Assembly may meet as necessary during an
3	extraordinary session under subdivision (b)(1) of this section, including
4	without limitation recessing for one (1) or more days and subsequently
5	reconvening.

7	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This amendment shall be effective on and
8	after November 9, 2022.

10	SECTION 3. BALLOT TITLE AND POPULAR NAME. When this proposed
11	amendment is submitted to the electors of this state on the general election

13	(1) The title of this Joint Resolution shall be the ballot
14	title; and
