19	WHEREAS, Coach Tom Harrell will coach his thirty-second season with the							
20	Mountainburg Dragons High School football program this fall and retire from							
21	coaching and education in December 2021; and							
22								
23	WHEREAS, Coach Harrell played high school football as a free safety at							
24	Alma High School under Coach Frank Vines in the late 1970s and early 1980s;							
25	and							
26								
27	WHEREAS, Coach Harrell attended Westark Community College for a year							
28	and a half and then attended Arkansas Tech University where he decided to go							
29	into coaching; and							
30								
31	WHEREAS, while attending Arkansas Tech University, Coach Harrell							
32	assisted Coach Rick Rachel at Danville High School and completed his student							
33	teaching under Coach Vines at Alma High School; and

35	WHEREAS, after graduating from Arkansas Tech University in 1987, Coach							
36	Harrell applied and interviewed for a junior basketball coaching job that was							



1	open at Mountainburg High School; and

3	WHEREAS, although Coach Harrell was not hired for the junior basketball
4	coaching job, he was offered a football coaching position at Mountainburg
5	High School; and
6	
7	WHEREAS, Coach Harrell was named the head football coach at
8	Mountainburg High School before the start of the 1990 season; and
9	
10	WHEREAS, under Coach Harrell, the Dragons are in their most successful
11	decade of the program with over sixty-seven (67) wins and have not had a
12	losing season since the 2000s; and
13	
14	WHEREAS, Coach Harrell has been flexible when it comes to adapting an
15	offense to his players, stating that "You've got to know the kids that you're
16	dealing with. Mountainburg kids are a little different than kids at some
17	schools. I know some coaches that they have a system, and they're going to
18	find kids to run their system. They've got enough kids to choose from. At a
19	school like this, you have to find a system that fits your kids"; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, Coach Harrell has also been creative when it comes to finding
22	ways for his team to be successful, stating that "I'm very creative and it's
23	more suited for a small school to be that way. I'm going to try to find some
24	advantage for our kids. It may be something crazy"; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, Coach Harrell joins legends Coach Mike Malham of Cabot, Coach
27	Jarrell Williams of Springdale, Coach David Alpe of Malvern, Coach Bernie Cox
28	of Little Rock Central, Coach Sam Coleman of Camden, and Coach Frank Vines of
29	Alma as a coach who has spent at least thirty (30) years at one (1) school,

31	NOW THEREFORE,
32	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE

35	THAT the Senate honor Coach Tom Harrell as the longest-tenured active
