17	TO EXTEND THE FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION
18	OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO
19	CONSIDER A BILL BY SENATOR GARNER TO
20	PROHIBIT THE PROPAGATION OF DIVISIVE
21	CONCEPTS IN CERTAIN PUBLIC ENTITIES.

23	WHEREAS, Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 19, provides that, after
24	the General Assembly has disposed of the business set forth in the Governor's
25	proclamation to convene an extraordinary session, the General Assembly may,
26	by a vote of two-thirds $(2/3)$ of all the members elected to both houses,
27	remain in session for a period not to exceed fifteen (15) days for the
28	purpose of transacting other legislative business; and

30	WHEREAS, the General Assembly has disposed of the matters set forth in
31	the Governor's proclamation calling the First Extraordinary Session of the
32	Ninety-Third General Assembly,
33	
34	NOW THEREFORE,
35	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
36	STATE OF ARKANSAS:

2	THAT the First Extraordinary Session of the Ninety-Third General
3	Assembly has completed action deemed to be necessary with respect to the
4	business set forth in the Governor's proclamation to convene the
5	extraordinary session.
6	
7	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the First Extraordinary Session of the
8	Ninety-Third General Assembly is extended in accordance with Arkansas
9	Constitution, Article 6, § 19, and shall remain in session for a period not
10	to exceed fifteen (15) days for the purpose of considering a bill by Senator
11	Garner to prohibit the propagation of divisive concepts in certain public
12	entities, including public schools and education service cooperatives.
