8 TO EXTEND THE FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE

10 REPRESENTATIVE BENTLEY TO REQUIRE TREATMENT GUIDES
11 AND INFORMATION ABOUT MEDICAL RESEARCH TRIALS TO BE
12 PROVIDED TO ALL INDIVIDUALS WHO TEST POSITIVE FOR
13 CORONAVIRUS 2019 (COVID-19) AND TO ENCOURAGE
14 HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS TO AGGRESSIVELY TREAT AN
15 INDIVIDUAL AS SOON AS THE INDIVIDUAL TESTS POSITIVE
16 FOR CORONAVIRUS 2019 (COVID-19).

20 TO EXTEND THE FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION
21 OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO
22 CONSIDER A BILL BY REPRESENTATIVE BENTLEY
23 CONCERNING THE TREATMENT AND INFORMATION
24 PROVIDED TO PERSONS TESTING POSITIVE FOR
25 COVID-19.

28 WHEREAS, Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 19, provides that, after
29 the General Assembly has disposed of the business set forth in the Governor's
30 proclamation to convene an extraordinary session, the General Assembly may,
31 by a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to both houses, remain in
32 session for a period not to exceed fifteen (15) days for the purpose of
33 transacting other legislative business; and

35 WHEREAS, the General Assembly has disposed of the matters set forth in
36 the Governor's proclamation calling the First Extraordinary Session of the

3 NOW THEREFORE,

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
5 STATE OF ARKANSAS:

7 THAT the First Extraordinary Session of the Ninety-Third General
8 Assembly has completed action deemed to be necessary with respect to the
9 business set forth in the Governor's proclamation to convene the
10 extraordinary session.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the First Extraordinary Session of the
13 Ninety-Third General Assembly is extended in accordance with Arkansas
14 Constitution, Article 6, § 19, and shall remain in session for a period not
15 to exceed fifteen (15) days for the purpose of considering a bill by
16 Representative Bentley to require treatment guides and information about
17 medical research trials to be provided to all individuals who test positive
18 for coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) and to encourage healthcare professionals to
19 aggressively treat an individual as soon as the individual tests positive for
20 coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19).
