19 October 03, 2021, at seventy-five (75) years of age; and

22 Marvell School District, and attended Arkansas Agricultural, Mechanical, &
23 Normal College, currently known as the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff;

27 United States Army in January 1967 and received his training at Fort Polk,
28 Louisiana and Fort Sill, Oklahoma; and

31 a Marvell City Police Officer and eventually became an Arkansas State
32 Trooper; and

34 WHEREAS, Mr. Nunn efficiently and effectively served the Arkansas State
35 Police for nearly twenty-five (25) years and retired as a corporal on June
36 30, 2008; and

3 and was honored to escort Muhammad Ali when the boxer visited Arkansas; and
