22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
25 Department of Corrections - Division of Community Correction for the 2022-
26 2023 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

10 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department
 11 of Corrections - Division of Community Correction for the 2022-2023 fiscal
 12 year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be
 13 known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such
 14 purposes: ten (10) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates
 15 of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and
 16 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate
 17 classification.

19 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
 20 appropriated, to the Department of Corrections, to be payable from the
 21 Division of Community Correction Fund Account, for personal services and
 22 operating expenses of the Department of Corrections - Division of Community
 23 Correction - State Operations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, the

22 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMMUNITY
24 CORRECTION PROGRAMS LINE ITEM USES. After seeking and receiving approval of
25 the Governor and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and upon approval by the
26 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the
27 Department of Corrections - Division of Community Correction, as authorized
28 by the Board of Corrections, is authorized to use funds appropriated for
29 "Community Correction Programs" line item of the Operations - Special Revenue
30 appropriation provided in this Act to construct new or renovate existing
31 facilities to support the development of community correction facilities in
32 the state.

33 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
34 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
35 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
36 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and

1 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
2 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
3 has determined that the Department of Corrections - Division of Community
4 Correction may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to
5 the Department of Corrections - Division of Community Correction authorizing
6 broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and
7 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior
8 approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by
9 this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or
10 Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the
11 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
12 is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire
13 section is void.

17 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PARKING
19 FEES. On July 1, of each year the Department of Corrections - Division of
20 Community Correction shall pay from the appropriation provided herein from
21 non-general revenue, the total amount appropriated for War Memorial Parking
22 Services from Fees to War Memorial.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
24 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

25
26 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
28 PROVISION. Upon seeking and receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer
29 of the State and review and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or
30 Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the Department of Corrections -
31 Division of Community Correction is authorized to transfer appropriation from
32 any line item authorized in the State Operations and Operations - Special
33 Revenue Appropriations of this Act to any other line item authorized in the
34 State Operations and Operations - Special Revenue Appropriations of this Act.
35 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
36 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year

1 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
2 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
3 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
4 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
5 has determined that the Department of Corrections - Division of Community
6 Correction may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to
7 the Department of Corrections - Division of Community Correction authorizing
8 broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and
9 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior
10 approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by

19 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
21 REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES. Upon determination by the Board of Corrections,
22 at the request of the Secretary of Corrections, that a reallocation of
23 resources within the Department of Corrections - Divisions of Community
24 Correction and Corrections is necessary for the efficient and effective
25 operation of the departments, the Board, with approval of the Governor and
26 approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, shall
27 have the authority to instruct the Department Secretary, to request from the
28 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, a transfer of positions, programs, funds,
29 appropriations, and line-item appropriations within or between existing and
30 newly created divisions, offices, sections, or units of the departments. If
31 it is determined that the requested transfer should be made, the Chief Fiscal
32 Officer of the State shall then initiate the necessary transfer documents to
33 reflect the transfers upon the fiscal records of the State Treasurer, the
34 State Auditor, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and the Department of
35 Corrections - Divisions of Correction and Community Correction. Provided,
36 however, that the Board shall be limited to submitting no more than two

1 requests, encompassing a single purpose listed in this section, during any
2 fiscal year per department. Transfer authority shall further be limited to
3 no more than five percent (5%) of the total General Revenue and Special
4 Revenue appropriation, funding, and positions specific to each division.
5 However, there shall be no transfers to or from the County Jail Reimbursement
6 Fund. A Reallocation of Resources Transfer shall be limited to the following
7 specific purposes:

- 8 a) Costs to open and operate temporary beds;
- 9 b) Payment of Debt Service;
- 10 c) Payment of Overtime Expenses;
- 11 d) Unanticipated increases for medical or private prison contracts;
- 12 e) Construction/renovation/equipping of new beds;
- 13 f) Deficits in Farm or Industry Program;
- 14 g) Losses not covered by insurance proceeds;
- 15 h) Costs of personnel for critical services or necessary to carry out the
16 mission of the agency.

17 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
18 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
19 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
20 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
21 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
22 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
23 has determined that the Department of Corrections - Divisions of Correction
24 and Community Correction may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is
25 provided to the Board of Corrections authorizing broad powers under the
26 Reallocation of Resources provisions herein. Therefore, it is both necessary
27 and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring
28 prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as
29 provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
30 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
31 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
32 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court jurisdiction, this entire
33 section is void.

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
35 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

1 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HOLIDAY
 3 COMPENSATION. The Department of Corrections - Division of Community
 4 Correction is authorized to pay employees for unused holidays in the
 5 employee's holiday account. Payments of unused holiday hours must be
 6 processed on or before June 1st in each fiscal year. Employees terminating
 7 employment from the Department of Corrections - Division of Community
 8 Correction will be eligible for all holiday pay accrued. This request is
 9 contingent on approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the
 10 Secretary of the Department of Corrections has verified that sufficient
 11 revenues are available to make such payments to employees in the following
 12 classifications, with the exception that those employees wishing to accrue
 13 banked hours be allowed the option to bank unused holiday hours in the
 14 employee's holiday account, not to exceed one-hundred fifty (150) hours:

31 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MEDICAL
 33 SERVICES - CONTINGENCY POSITIONS. If it has been determined by the Board of
 34 Corrections that the Department of Corrections - Division of Community
 35 Correction cannot continue a medical contract with a private provider and the
 36 Board deems it necessary to utilize staff to provide the required services,

1 the Department of Corrections - Division of Community Correction is allowed,
 2 upon notification of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after seeking
 3 prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee,
 4 to utilize the contingent positions for medical services contained in this
 5 Act and make the appropriate transfers from the Professional Fees and
 6 Services line item contained in the State Operations Appropriation of this
 7 Act to Regular Salaries, Personal Services Matching and various Maintenance
 8 and General Operations classifications. Further, the Department may utilize
 9 the service(s) of a state-based or national-based Professional Recruitment
 10 Service, or network, as may be necessary to recruit, fill, or maintain the
 11 occupancy of the positions stated herein.

12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
 13 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

14
 15 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REGULAR
 17 SALARIES - CONTINGENT POSITIONS. There is hereby established for the
 18 Department of Corrections - Division of Community Correction - Contingent
 19 Positions for the ~~2021-2022~~ 2022-2023 fiscal year, the following maximum
 20 number of regular employees.

 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMMUNITY
 17 CORRECTION PROGRAMS LINE ITEM USES. After seeking and receiving approval of
 18 the Governor and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and upon approval by the
 19 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the
 20 Department of Corrections - Division of Community Correction, as authorized
 21 by the Board of Corrections, is authorized to use the appropriations
 22 authorized under the line item established herein for "Community Correction
 23 Programs" are to be used by the Department of Corrections - Division of
 24 Community Correction for establishment and operation of, to include
 25 construction, renovation, and contracting for establishment and operation of,
 26 residential and non-residential community correction programs such as, but
 27 not limited to, community correction centers, drug, alcohol, and mental
 28 health treatments, intensive supervision, restitution, and others as
 29 established and approved by the Board of Corrections and as may be provided
 30 by law.

31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~

 34 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
 36 AUTHORITY FOR UTILITY AND FUEL RATE INCREASE. In the event of a ten percent

1 (10%) increase in utility and fuel rates, the Department of Corrections -
2 Division of Community Correction is authorized to transfer from any line item
3 in the State Operations Appropriation to the Operating Expense line item in
4 the State Operations Appropriation for support of the increase after
5 receiving approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Prior to the
6 utilization of the transfer authority a report shall be made to the Arkansas
7 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee including justification for the
8 transfer and the amount of transfer.

9 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
10 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
11 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
12 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
13 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
14 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
15 has determined that the Department of Corrections - Division of Community
16 Correction may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to
17 the Department of Corrections - Division of Community Correction authorizing
18 broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and
19 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior
20 approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by
21 this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or
22 Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the
23 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
24 is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire
25 section is void.

26 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~

29 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY
31 JAIL INVOICE SUMMARY. The Divisions of Correction and Community Correction,
32 shall at a minimum and on a fiscal year basis, prepare and post on the
33 applicable agency web site, a monthly summary of county jail reimbursement
34 invoices prepared and forwarded to each county sheriff for verification by
35 the Departments and for payment from the County Jail Reimbursement Fund. In
36 addition, the report shall include a summary of invoices returned by each

1 county for payment for previous months within the fiscal year, the amounts
2 paid, and any balances owed. Each fiscal year-end report shall be maintained
3 on the web sites for a period of no less than three (3) years.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
5 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

6
7 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR
9 VEHICLE PURCHASE PROVISION. The Department of Corrections - Division of
10 Community Correction is hereby authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the
11 appropriations authorized for Capital Outlay in the State Operations and
12 Special Revenue Operations appropriations in this Act.

13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
14 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

15
16 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

18 PAROLE/PROBATION OFFICERS HIRING. The Department of Corrections - Division
19 of Community Correction shall report quarterly to the Arkansas Legislative
20 Council or Joint Budget Committee the number of vacant Parole/Probation
21 Officer, Parole/Probation Area Manager, Parole/Probation Assistant Area
22 Manager positions and average case load per Parole/Probation Officer.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
24 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

25
26 SECTION 19. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
27 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
28 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
29 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
30 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
31 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
32 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
33 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
34 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

35
36 SECTION 20. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

1 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
2 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
3 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
4 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
5 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
6 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
7 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

8
9 SECTION 21. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
10 2022.
