There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education -5 Arkansas School for the Deaf, to be payable from the Development and 6 Enhancement Fund, the following: 7 (A) for various maintenance, renovation, equipping, construction, 8 acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and repair of real property and facilities 9 at the Arkansas School for the Deaf campus, in a sum not to 10 exceed......\$15,000,000. 11

12 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL, AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS 13 14 SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND - TRANSFER PROVISION.
