8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 HUMAN SERVICES - DIVISION OF DEVELOPMENTAL
11 DISABILITIES SERVICES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

14 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
15 SERVICES - DIVISION OF DEVELOPMENTAL
16 DISABILITIES SERVICES REAPPROPRIATION.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES SERVICES.

22 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services, to be
23 payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of
24 the State, for the Department of Human Services - Division of Developmental
25 Disabilities Services the following:
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27 (A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2021, for implementation of the
29 Booneville Human Development Center master plan including costs associated
30 with demolition, construction, replacement, renovation, upgrade, and addition
31 of facilities at the Booneville Human Development Center, in a sum not to
32 exceed\$1,184,925.

33 (B) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
34 in Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2021, for implementation of the
35 residential housing plan of the Booneville Human Development Center master
36 plan including costs associated with demolition, construction, replacement,



1 renovation, upgrade, and addition of facilities at the Booneville Human
2 Development Center, in a sum not to exceed\$7,819,000.

3 (C) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
4 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 869 of 2021, for continued implementation of
5 the master plans at each Human Development Center including demolition,
6 construction, replacement, upgrade, and addition of facilities, in a sum not
7 to exceed\$15,000,000.

8 (D) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
9 in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 869 of 2021, for costs associated with
10 construction of five (5) living units for medically fragile residents as part
11 of the master plan at the Conway Human Development Center, in a sum not to
12 exceed\$12,000,000.

13 (E) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
14 in Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 869 of 2021, for construction of new medical
15 facilities at the five (5) Human Development Centers in accordance with the
16 master plans at each Human Development Center, in a sum not to exceed
17\$6,000,000.

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19 SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
20 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
21 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
22 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
23 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
24 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
25 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
26 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
27 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
28 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
29 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
30 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

31 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
32 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
33 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
34 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
35 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
36 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided

1 otherwise by law.

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3 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
4 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
5 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
6 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
7 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
8 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
9 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
10 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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12 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
13 2022.
