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2 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - NCRC GRANT. There is hereby appropriated, 3 to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and 4 Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Secretary of State the 5 following:

6 (A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
7 in Section 24 of Act 832 of 2021, for the acquisition, management,
8 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
9 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$250,000.
10 (B) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided

11 in Section 24 of Act 832 of 2021, for the acquisition, management, 12 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, 13 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed\$1,075,430. 14

15 SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor 16 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects 17 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available 18 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and 19 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and 20 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or 21 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State 22 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects 23 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds 24 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General 25 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall 26 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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35 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
