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19	SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - VARIOUS INDUSTRY PROJECTS - CASH. There
20	is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Corrections, to be payable from
21	the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief
22	Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of Corrections - Division of
23	Correction the following:
24	(A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
25	in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 213 of 2021, for construction, renovation and
26	major maintenance of facilities and Central Warehouse of the Division of
27	Correction, in a sum not to exceed\$5,000,000.
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29	SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - VARIOUS INDUSTRY PROJECTS. There is
30	hereby appropriated, to the Department of Corrections, to be payable from the
31	Division of Correction Prison Industry Fund, for the Department of
32	Corrections - Division of Correction the following:
33	(A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
34	in Item (A) of Section 5 of Act 999 of 2021, for maintenance, replacement,
35	repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase,
36	improvement, and upgrade of the Department of Corrections - Various Industry

1	Projects, in a sum not to exceed\$1,000,000.
2	(B) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
3	in Item (A) of Section 4 of Act 213 of 2021, for maintenance, replacement,
4	repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase, improvement
5	and upgrade of the Division of Correction - Various Industry Projects, in a
6	sum not to exceed\$6,312.
7	(C) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
8	in Item (B) of Section 4 of Act 213 of 2021, for various industry projects
9	including storage at the Wrightsville Unit near the industry buildings, in a
10	sum not to exceed\$150,000.
11	(D) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
12	in Item (C) of Section 4 of Act 213 of 2021, for various industry projects
13	for maintenance, replacement, repair, expansion, construction, equipping,
14	renovation, purchase, improvement, and upgrade of the Division of Correction,

25	(A) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
26	in Item (A) of Section 4 of Act 999 of 2021, for maintenance, replacement,
27	repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase,
28	improvement, and upgrade of the Department of Corrections - Various Farm
29	Projects, in a sum not to exceed\$1,000,000.
30	(B) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
31	in Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 213 of 2021, for maintenance, replacement,
32	repair, expansion, construction, equipping, renovation, purchase,
33	improvement, and upgrade of the Division of Correction - Various Farm
34	Projects, in a sum not to exceed\$1,000,000.
35	(C) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
36	in Item (B) of Section 3 of Act 213 of 2021, for construction of grain

1	storage pins at the East Arkansas Unit, in a sum not to exceed\$200,000.
2	(D) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
3	in Item (C) of Section 3 of Act 213 of 2021, for construction of grain
4	storage bins at the Tucker Unit, in a sum not to exceed\$200,000.
5	(E) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
6	in Item (D) of Section 3 of Act 213 of 2021, for renovation of the current
7	dairy facility and replacement of equipment, in a sum not to exceed
8	\$2,799,800.
9	(F) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
10	in Item (E) of Section 3 of Act 213 of 2021, for construction of grain
11	storage bins at Cummins, Tucker and East Arkansas Units, in a sum not to
12	exceed\$2,430,250.
13	(G) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
14	in Item (F) of Section 3 of Act 213 of 2021, for maintenance and repair to
15	upgrade the existing feed mill at the Cummins Unit, in a sum not to exceed
16	\$889,750.
17	(H) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
18	in Item (G) of Section 3 of Act 213 of 2021, for Irrigation Project at
19	Tucker/Cummins, in a sum not to exceed\$110,000.
20	(I) Effective July 1, 2022, the balance of the appropriation provided
21	in Item (H) of Section 3 of Act 213 of 2021, for various farm projects for
22	maintenance, replacement, repair, expansion, construction, equipping,
23	renovation, purchase, improvement, and upgrade of the Division of Correction,
24	in a sum not to exceed\$1,000,000.
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26	SECTION 7. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
27	obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
28	described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
29	therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
30	agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
31	donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
32	funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
33	Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
34	enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
35	otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
36	Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall

1	not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.
2	(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
3	Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
4	Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
5	this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
6	Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
7	disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
8	otherwise by law.
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10	SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
11	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
12	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
13	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
14	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
15	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
16	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
17	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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19	SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
