25	has been celebrated annually since 1976; was inspired by the birthdays of	
26	Abraham Lincoln and Frederick Douglass; and

28	WHEREAS, the celebration of Black History Month and the study of	
29	African American history is part of the legacy of Dr. Carter G. Woodson; and

31	WHEREAS, the progress of African Americans in the nation and in the	
32	State of Arkansas has been marked with both the tragedy of social	
33	inequalities and the triumph of group achievements; and

10	Representative John Walker, and Maya Angelou just to name a few, there are
11	less known but equally impactful individuals who we should educate ourselves
12	on such as Crispus Attucks, William Harvey Carney, the Greensboro Four,
13	Constance Baker-Motley, and a plethora of historical giants,
