- trials suspended, and the basic functions of visiting with witnesses and clients virtually grinding to a halt due to social distancing and masking rules put in place at the beginning of the pandemic.
 - (b) Now, with criminal trials resuming for the time being, the backlog of criminal cases remains, putting undue stress on the state's prosecutors who are still attempting to resolve the thousands of backlogged cases while contending with the normal influx of new criminal cases.
 - (c)(1) The General Assembly intends for the appropriation provided for under this section to be used for the hiring of additional deputy prosecuting attorneys for a certain and limited period of time in order to help reduce the backlog in criminal cases that currently exists throughout the state.
- (2) Specifically, it is the intent of the General Assembly that
 the appropriation provided for under this section be given to the office of
 the Prosecutor Coordinator for the office to hire, in its discretion, up to
 forty-five (45) additional attorneys in either a full-time or part-time
 capacity, subject to lawful terms negotiated by the office, to address the
 backlog in criminal cases.
 - (3) This section does not create new, permanent positions in the office but rather provides funding for extra help for a limited term to be negotiated by the office in its discretion.

SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

1	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
2	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
3	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

5	SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
