14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
15 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

16
17 SECTION 42. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
19 PROVISION. If the State Forestry Commission determines that temporary
20 firefighters, dispatchers, or pilots are required to meet the demands of a
21 wildfire season, and upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
22 appropriations may be transferred from either Extra Help or Professional Fees
23 and Services to the proper character code for the employment of such
24 personnel.

25 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the deployment of air
26 tankers for fighting wildfires requires additional Professional Fees and
27 Services, and upon the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
28 excess appropriation in Regular Salaries or Personal Services Matching may be
29 transferred to Professional Fees and Services in the Operations and Forestry
30 - Rural Community Fire Protection - Federal appropriation sections.

31 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the most effective way for
32 it to cooperate in the growing and distribution of forest planting stock is
33 by contracting work with private vendors and/or hiring temporary employees
34 for seasonal work, the Commission is hereby authorized, upon approval by the
35 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to transfer the necessary appropriation
36 authorized for Extra Help and Maintenance and General Operation in the

1 Operations and Forestry - Rural Community Fire Protection - Federal
2 appropriation sections.

3 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
4 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

6 SECTION 43. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REFUND TO
8 EXPENDITURE. The Arkansas Forestry Commission is authorized to charge fees
9 to federal agencies and other states to reimburse the Commission for
10 expenditures made on behalf of these governmental units. These fees shall be
11 deposited into the State Forestry Fund in the State Treasury as a refund to
12 expenditure.

13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
14 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

16 SECTION 44. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
18 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall establish
19 upon request for the Arkansas Agriculture Department a special Promotional
20 Items appropriation to be used in the acquisition of promotional items.
21 When the Arkansas Agriculture Department wishes to transfer from its
22 operating expenses to the promotional items line, the request shall be
23 forwarded by the Arkansas Agriculture Department to the Chief Fiscal Officer
24 of the State for processing and for prior approval by the Arkansas
25 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Determining the maximum
26 number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general
27 revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the
28 General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums
29 in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and the general revenue
30 allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the
31 Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that
32 the Arkansas Agriculture Department may operate more efficiently if some
33 flexibility is provided to the Arkansas Agriculture Department authorizing
34 broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and
35 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior
36 approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by

1 this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or
2 Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the
3 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
4 is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire
5 section is void.

6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
7 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

8

9 SECTION 45. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
10 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
11 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
12 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
15 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
16 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

18

19 SECTION 46. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
21 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
22 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

27

28 SECTION 47. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
29 2022.
