1 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department 2 of Energy and Environment - Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board for the 2022-2023 3 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary 4 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated 5 herein for such purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time employee, when 6 needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform 7 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the 8 appropriate classification.

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10 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, 11 to the Department of Energy and Environment, to be payable from the Liquefied 12 Petroleum Gas Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the 13 Department of Energy and Environment - Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board for the 14 fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, the following:

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SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 29 30 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 31 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 32 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 33 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 34 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 35 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 36 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1, 2022. /s/Joint Budget Committee
