1 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - GEOSTOR AND FRAMEWORK. There is hereby 2 appropriated, to the Department of Transformation and Shared Services -3 Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office, to be payable from the 4 Geographic Information Systems Fund, to carry out the duties, 5 responsibilities, and authority of the Arkansas State Land Information Board 6 as described by Arkansas Code 15-21-504; to create, operate, and maintain 7 Geostor, the Arkansas Spatial Data Infrastructure; and to create, update, 8 maintain, and disseminate framework spatial data as defined by Arkansas Code 9 15-21-502 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, the following: 10 11 ITEM FISCAL YEAR 12 NO. 2022-2023 (01) GEOSTOR & FRAMEWORK 13 \$1,200,000 14

15 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 17 OF CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of funds remaining on June 30 of 18 each fiscal year in the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account for the Arkansas 19 Geographic Information Office, shall be transferred to the Geographic 20 Information Systems Fund to be used for operating and maintaining the 21 Arkansas Spatial Data Infrastructure, creating, updating, maintaining and 22 disseminating framework spatial data as defined by Arkansas Code §15-21-502. 23 (1) Prior to June 30, 2022 2023 the Agency shall by written statement set 24 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the 25 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget; 26 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall 27 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the 28 September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting 29 which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or 30 Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name 31 or line item, the funding source of the appropriation and a copy of the 32 written request set forth in (1) above; 33 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written

34 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
35 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
36 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose, etc.

Disbursement of funds 12 13 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 14 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 15 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 18 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 19 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 20 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

22 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 23 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 24 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 25 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 26 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 27 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 28 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 29 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 30
