25 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
27 OF FUNDS - JUSTICE BUILDING OPERATIONS ACTUAL EXPENDITURES. Building
28 Authority Division may from time to time as may be necessary and in such
29 amounts as may be necessary and with the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer
30 of the State, request a transfer of funds from the State Central Services
31 Fund to the Arkansas Building Authority Maintenance Fund for operation of the
32 Justice Building for actual expenditures, in an amount not to exceed the
33 dollar amount appropriated in the Justice Building Operation Section. Upon
34 his approval, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall then initiate the
35 necessary transfer documents to reflect the transfer upon the fiscal records
36 of the State Auditor, the State Treasurer, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the

1 State and Building Authority Division.

2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
3 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

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5 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
7 OF FUNDS. Building Authority Division is hereby authorized, after seeking
8 the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Arkansas
9 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee to request transfer from the
10 appropriation made in the Building Maintenance Section for Building
11 Maintenance to the Acquisition and Maintenance appropriation in the
12 Acquisition and Maintenance Section and to receive from another state agency
13 that seeks like approvals its authority, appropriation and the transfer of
14 funds to be deposited into the Building Authority Division Real Estate Fund
15 to become part of the Acquisition and Maintenance appropriation, and to be
16 used for any purposes as set forth by law for said Real Estate Fund.

17 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
18 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
19 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
20 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
21 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
22 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
23 has determined that Building Authority Division may operate more efficiently
24 if some flexibility is provided to Building Authority Division authorizing
25 broad powers under this section. Therefore, it is both necessary and
26 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior
27 approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by
28 this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or
29 Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the
30 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
31 is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire
32 section is void.

33 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
34 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

36 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. BUILDING
2 AUTHORITY DIVISION CONTINGENCY APPROPRIATION TRANSFER AUTHORITY. Building
3 Authority Division may transfer appropriation and funds as needed from the
4 Facilities Management Contingency Appropriation in the Building Maintenance
5 Section of this Act to any appropriation authorized for Building Authority
6 Division.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
8 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

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10 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
12 TO FACILITIES MANAGEMENT CONTINGENCY APPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. (a) In order to
13 provide a more cost effective method to address the emerging infrastructure
14 needs of Arkansas State Government, appropriations and funds transferred to
15 the Facilities Management Contingency Appropriation are to be used in the
16 event that the Building Authority Division executes one or more building
17 contracts or maintenance agreements with State Agencies, and the
18 appropriations or funds otherwise provided for the Building Authority
19 Division are not sufficient to address those needs, and it is more cost
20 effective for Building Authority Division to execute these services. Any
21 State Agency may transfer or deposit funds and appropriations to Building
22 Authority Division - Facilities Management Contingency Appropriation
23 authorized in the Building Maintenance Section of this Act to execute one or
24 more building contracts or maintenance agreements with said State Agencies.
25 Building Authority Division shall provide justification to the Chief Fiscal
26 Officer of the State for the need of such appropriations and funds transfers
27 and seek and receive approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.
28 Building Authority Division shall then seek and receive the approval of the
29 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. The requirement of
30 approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not
31 a severable part of the section. If the requirement of approval by the
32 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled
33 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is
34 void.

35 (b) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall make the necessary
36 adjustments on his or her books and the books of the Auditor of the State for

1 the transfer or deposit of the funds and appropriations from each State
2 Agency to the appropriation authorized in the Building Maintenance Section of
3 this Act and to the various Building Authority Division accounts to be used
4 exclusively by Building Authority Division for the fiscal year.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
6 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

7
8 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

10 SUSTAINABLE BUILDING DESIGN PROGRAM - TRANSFER. In the event there is not
11 sufficient appropriation and/or funding provided for by the General Assembly
12 for any state agency, board or commission to participate in the Sustainable
13 Building Design Program for renovations of state owned property which exceeds
14 two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000), the agency may request a
15 transfer from the Sustainable Building Design Program appropriation
16 authorized in the Sustainable Building Design Program Section of this Act
17 from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. The request shall clearly state
18 the amount required and such other information as may be required by the
19 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State necessary to make a decision regarding the
20 request. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior
21 review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the
22 State Auditor shall be notified as of the amount and the purposes for which
23 the appropriation and/or funding is to be transferred and shall be
24 established upon the books of the Department of Finance and Administration
25 and the State Auditor. If desired, the appropriation may be supplemental to
26 those regularly appropriated for like purposes by the General Assembly for
27 that agency.

28 Provided further, that all state agencies, boards or commissions shall
29 have prior approval by the Building Authority Division as authorized for the
30 Sustainable Building Design Program in accordance with established Rules and
31 Regulations.

32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
33 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

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35 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

1 SUSTAINABLE BUILDING DESIGN PROGRAM - REVOLVING LOAN FUND. The Sustainable
2 Building Design Program Appropriation is intended to provide additional
3 appropriation authority for the Sustainable Building Design Program. Funding
4 for the program may be made available by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
5 State, in the form of a loan, from a transfer from the Sustainable Building
6 Design Revolving Loan Fund after the required review by the Arkansas
7 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, approval by the Chief Fiscal
8 Officer of the State and approval through rules and regulations established
9 and administered by Building Authority Division. Moneys made available for
10 the repayment of a loan shall be deposited to the credit of the Sustainable
11 Building Design Revolving Loan Fund as a "Refund to Expenditure" for the year
12 in which the deposit is made. In the event that the funds for the repayment
13 of a loan are held in depositories other than the State Treasury, the
14 administrative head of the affected state agency shall issue a check drawn
15 against the funds, which shall be deposited in the Sustainable Building
16 Design Revolving Loan Fund.

17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
18 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

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20 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
22 TRANSFER - DEVELOPMENT AND ENHANCEMENT FUNDS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of
23 the State may transfer from time to time on his or her books and those of the
24 State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State funding which is made available
25 from Development and Enhancement Funds allocated and distributed to Building
26 Authority Division in an amount not to exceed three million dollars
27 (\$3,000,000) from the Development and Enhancement Fund or its successor fund
28 or fund accounts to the Sustainable Building Design Revolving Loan Fund to
29 provide funds for the appropriation provided herein or for appropriation
30 authority as may be provided by law to provide loans to agencies for the
31 Sustainable Building Design Program.

32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
33 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

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35 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING

1 TRANSFER - FEDERAL FUNDS. From time to time, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
2 State may transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and
3 the Auditor of the State the sum not to exceed twelve million dollars
4 (\$12,000,000) from Federal Funds as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of
5 the State to the Sustainable Building Design Revolving Loan Fund to provide
6 funds for the appropriations herein.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
8 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

9
10 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
12 TRANSFER - CASH FUND ACCOUNT. Building Authority Division is authorized to
13 transfer any unspent funds remaining in any cash fund account established for
14 the management of a state owned facility managed by, but not owned by,
15 Building Authority Division to the Building Authority Maintenance Fund to
16 support the facility's Maintenance and Operations appropriations.

17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
18 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

19
20 SECTION 23. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
21 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
22 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
23 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
24 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
25 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
26 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
27 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
28 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

29
30 SECTION 24. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
31 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
32 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
33 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
34 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
35 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
36 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

1 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 25. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1, 2022.
